AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

SYNOPSIS: the victim and the known suspect got into an argument about the money that the victim owed to the suspect. The suspect then left and came back a few hours later. The suspect shot the victim in the head before fleeing the scene. The suspect was arrested by Columbus SWAY and SOFAST.

CASE STATUS: Detective received the video footage and obtained a search warrant which lead to the suspect's arrest.

AGGRAVATED ROBBERY

SYNOPSIS: The victim got into a vehicle with the three known suspects. Once inside the vehicle, one of the suspect's put a gun to the victim's lower back while he choked her. The second suspect was driving and the third suspect reclined his seat back as to pin the victim inside the vehicle and held a knife to the victim's throat. They demanded money, so the victim gave them her purse and they kicked her out of the vehicle. The suspects then fled the scene. A broadcast was made for the three suspects.

CASE STATUS: Detective attempted to make contact with the victim, but was met with negative results.

The victim then fled the store and the store employee ran out, but locked the suspects inside the store until police arrived. The suspect was arrested and transported to the Montgomery County Jail.

CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who did not speak English. The detective advised the victim to contact him when he returned to the City limits, so a meeting with a translator could be arranged. This case was presented to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office and marked for further investigation.

The suspect then fled in the victim's vehicle.</p> <p>CASE STATUS: Detective attempted to make contact with the victim regarding cameras in the area that were observed, but was met with negative results.</p>

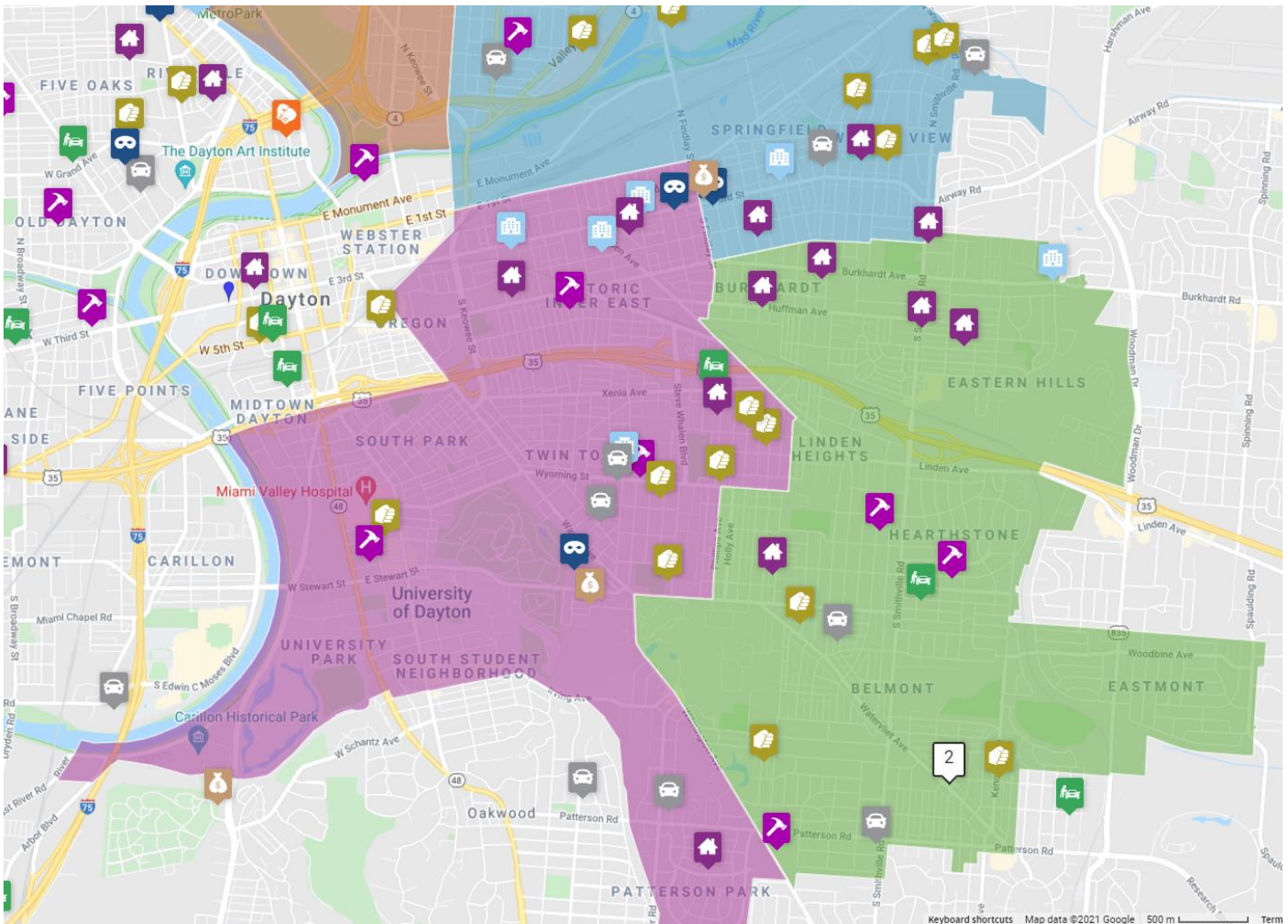
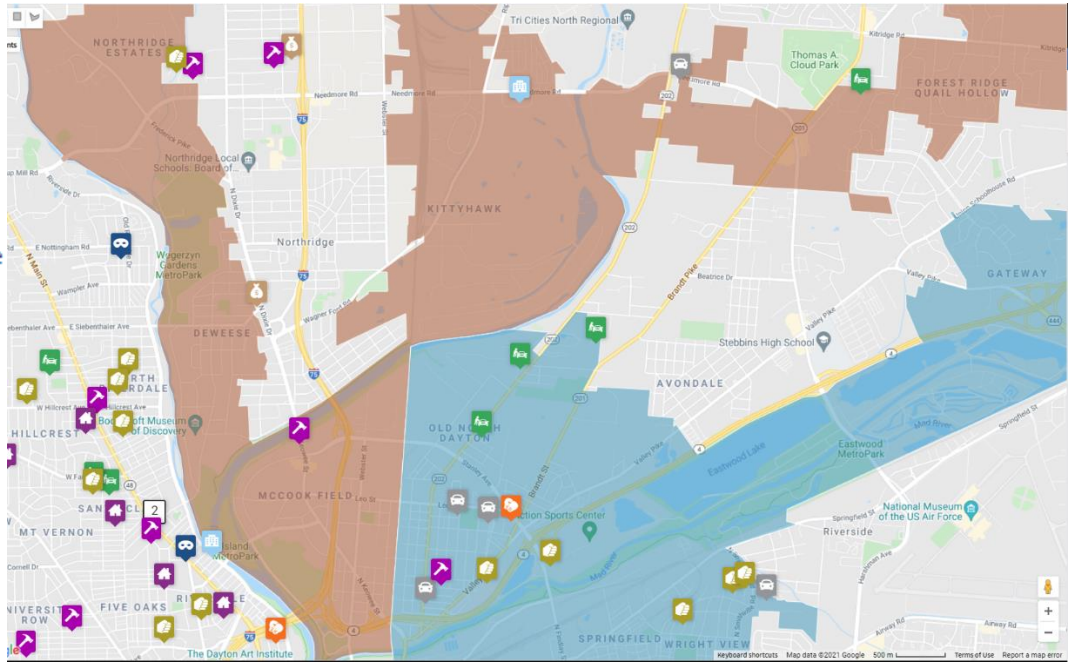

How to Prevent Trailer Thefts



- Use a hitch lock- this makes it more time consuming for thieves to steal your trailer
- Park your trailer in a well-lit area- most criminals do not want to be seen committing crimes
- You can also park your trailer in an area such as a fenced backyard or garage
- Make sure you have the license plate or registration information written down
- Mark your trailer with identifiable marks
- Block the tires with tire blocks or cinder blocks
- Lock your wheels
- Remember, if you see something, say something

Catalytic converter theft

is on the rise in your neighborhood

An exhaust admission control device that reduces toxic gases and pollutants in exhaust gas

Contains valuable metals such as platinum

SUV's, because of their height, (easier to get to converter) and lighter weight cars, such as the Prius, (easier to jack up, if needed) are common targets, but all types of vehicles are prone to this theft. It only takes about 5 minutes to steal your converter.



What can you do to prevent Catalytic converter thefts?

- Park your car in your garage whenever possible
- Park in a well-lit area
- Set your car alarm to pick up vibrations
- Use motion sensor lights in your driveway

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE FRAUD ALERT

This is a Fraud Alert from the Office of Inspector General at the U.S. Department of Labor.

Fraudsters are perpetrating numerous schemes related to the COVID-19 pandemic. In one scheme, scammers have offered to help individuals file claims for unemployment benefits. The scammers then ask for personal information including social security numbers and dates of birth. The scammers may ask you to provide payment, or your credit card information, in assisting you in filing or qualifying for your unemployment benefits. You do not need to pay anyone to file or qualify for your benefits.

Unsolicited calls, social media platforms, and door-to-door visits are several ways that individuals have been targeted.

Be aware that your personal information may be used fraudulently without your permission.

Victims of these scams face potential harm. The personal information the scammers collect may be used to commit identity theft to file fraudulent unemployment insurance claims.
