## AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

<b>SYNOPSIS:</b> The victim noticed that the known suspect was trying to harm two men in the alley near their residence. When the victim popped his head down the alley, the suspect turned around and said "you on the snitch side?" After the suspect tried to hit the victim, the victim ran. The suspect tackled the victim and hit him in the head numerous times with a metal baton before fleeing the scene.			
<b>CASE STATUS:</b> No detective supplementary report entered at this time.

<b>SYNOPSIS:</b> The victim got into an argument with a friend, but he would not tell the officers his friend's name. The suspect stabbed the victim during this verbal argument that turned physical. Both individuals were highly intoxicated.			
<b>CASE STATUS:</b> No detective supplementary report entered at this time.

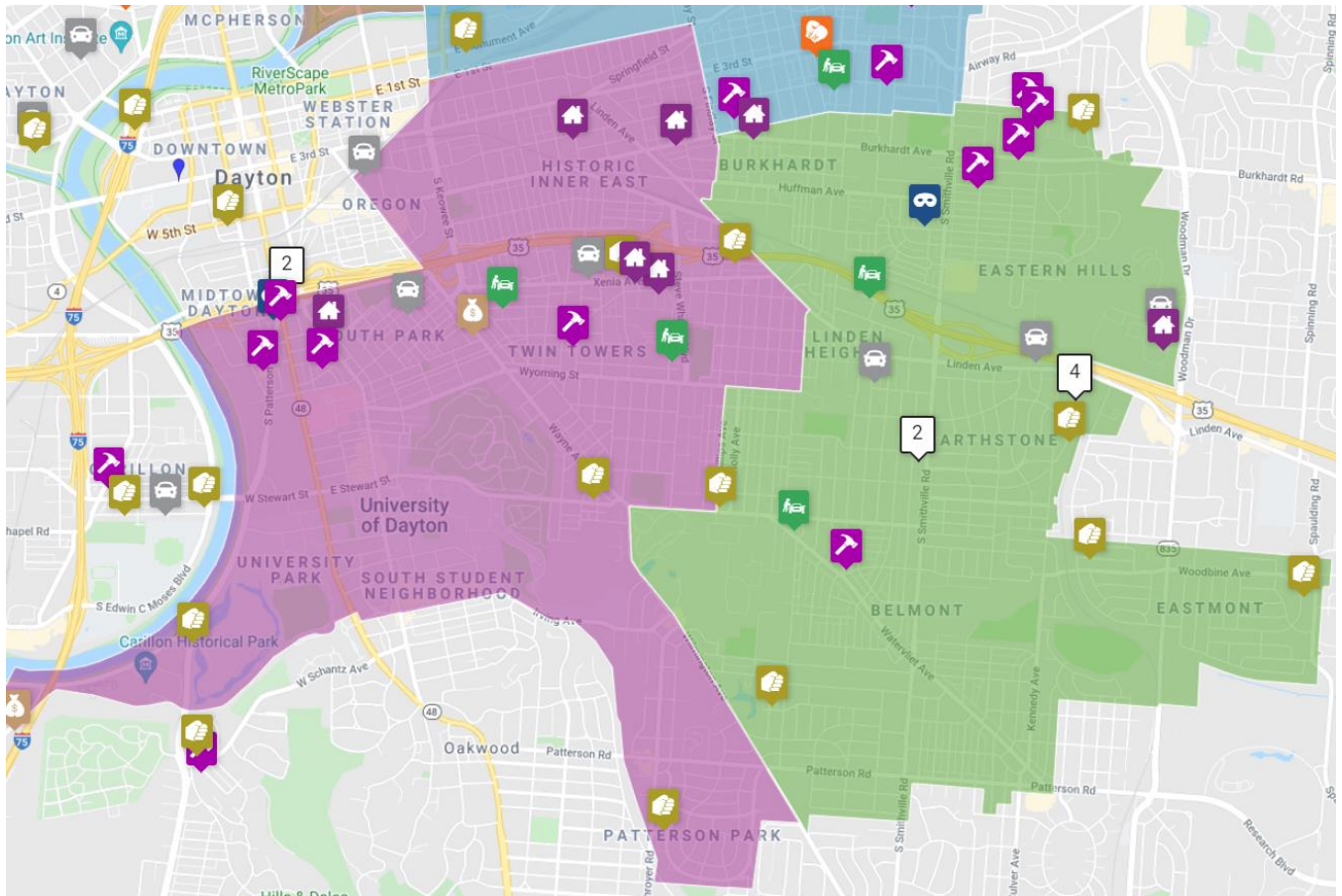
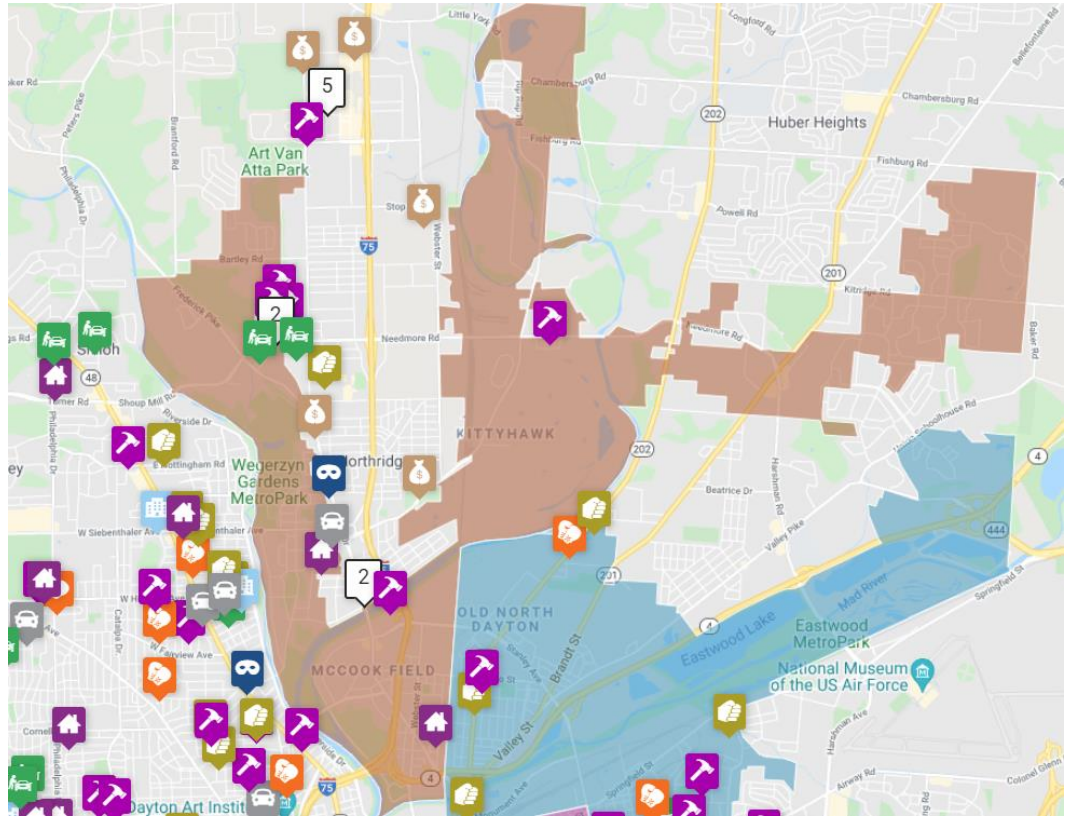

# How to Prevent Trailer Thefts



- Use a hitch lock- this makes it more time consuming for thieves to steal your trailer
- Park your trailer in a well-lit area- most criminals do not want to be seen committing crimes
- You can also park your trailer in an area such as a fenced backyard or garage
- Make sure you have the license plate or registration information written down
- Mark your trailer with identifiable marks
- Block the tires with tire blocks or cinder blocks
- Lock your wheels
- Remember, if you see something, say something

## DO YOU NEED A SAFE PLACE FOR YOUR BABY TO SLEEP?

*Families must meet the following requirements to participate in the Safe Sleep Program:*

- Have no other safe sleep space such as crib, pack 'n play or bassinet or ability to obtain one
- Families eligible for receiving government assistance such as WIC, Medicaid, etc.
- At least 32 weeks pregnant or a child under 6 months of age
- Receive safe sleep education and complete required paperwork
- One pack 'n play or cribette per child

In Ohio, three babies die each week in unsafe sleep environments. These deaths are preventable by keeping in mind a few safe sleep ABC's: Babies are safest **Alone**, on their **Back**, in an empty **Crib**.



Public Health – Dayton & Montgomery County, in collaboration with Ohio Department of Health and Cribs for Kids is providing Infant Survival Kits to parents and caregivers in our community. The Infant Survival Kit includes a cribette, fitted sheet, and educational safe sleep material.
