SYNOPSIS: (This is a cross complaint.) The male and the female got into an argument over some money that the female said the male owed her. Both the male and female are fiances to one another. The female stabbed the male over the money that was owed, but she tried claiming self defense.			
CASE STATUS: Charges were presented to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office and refused.

SYNOPSIS: The victim was working at Ray's Drive Thru when a white Dodge pulled in containing the two suspects being disorderly. They then stole alcohol and energy drinks. The victim may have a possible broken finger that she sustained during this fight.

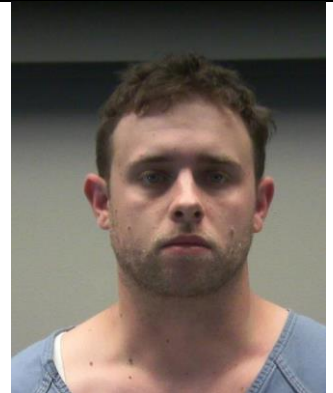

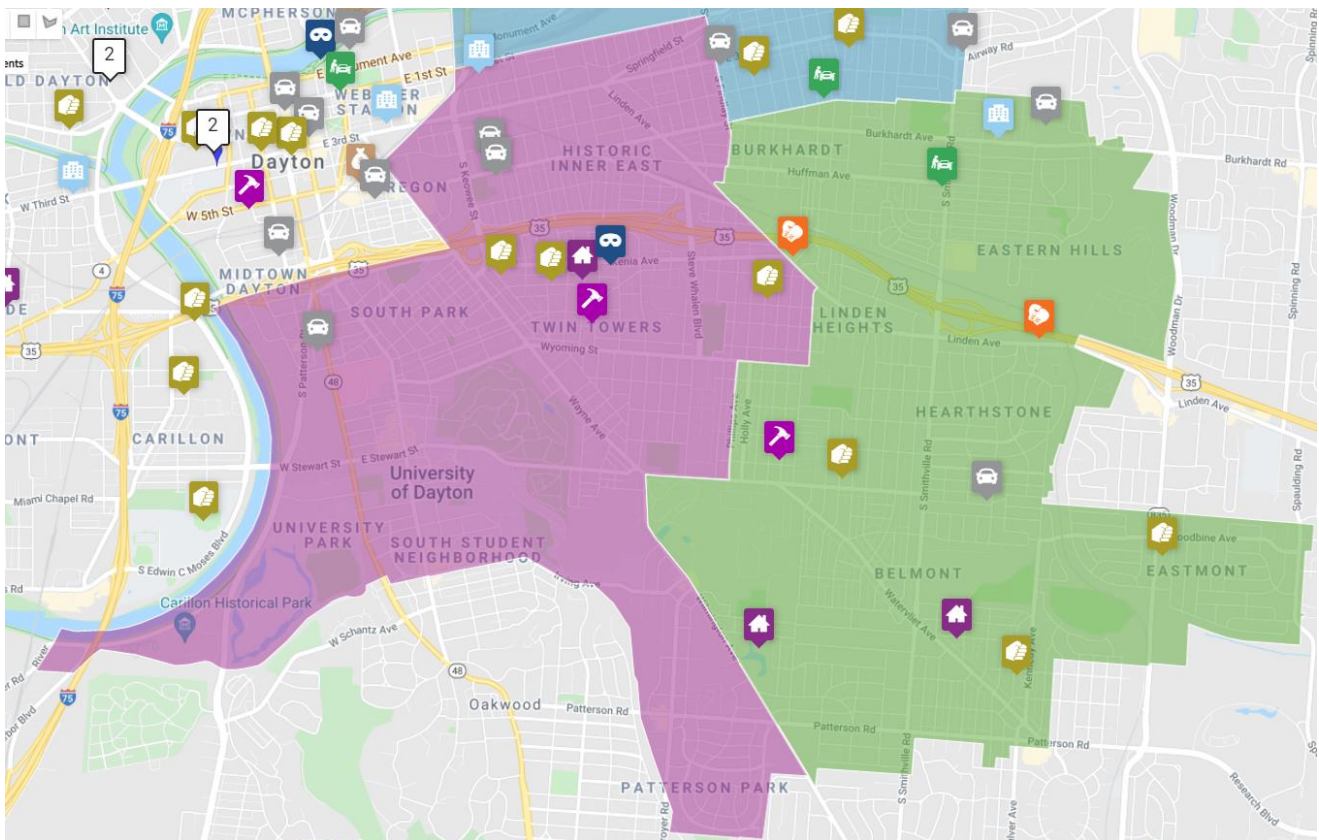
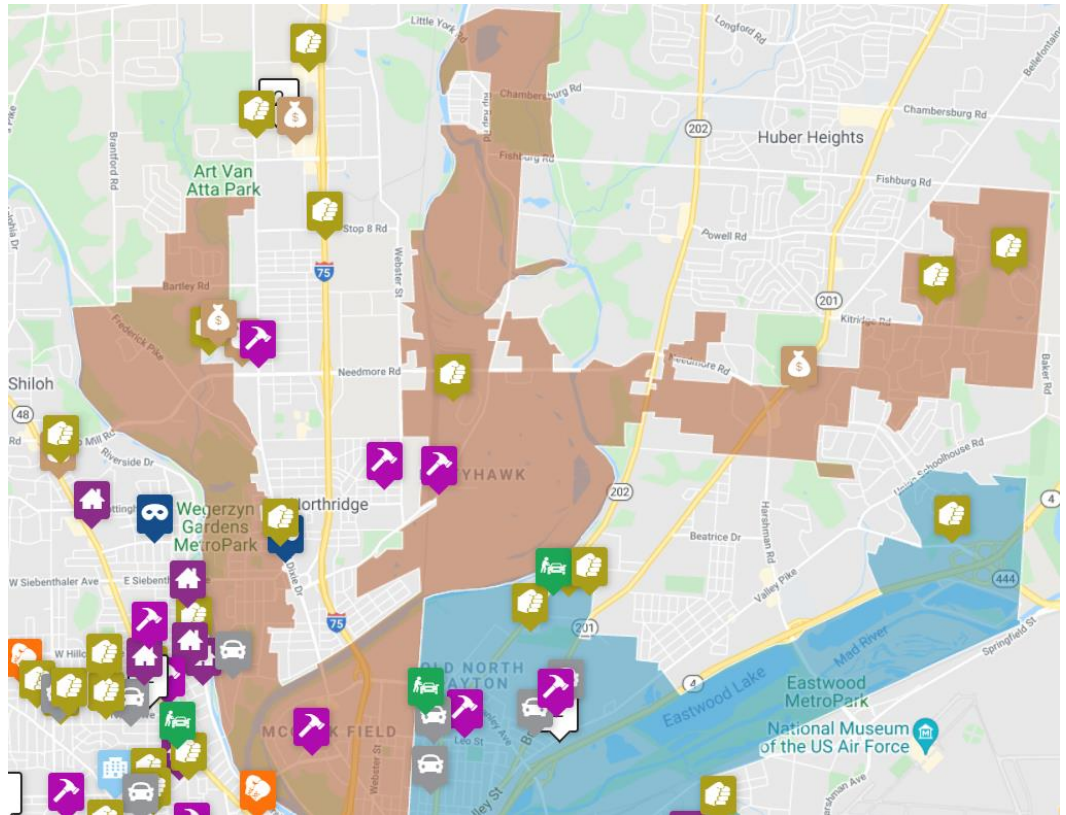
Upcoming COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics

How to Prevent Trailer Thefts



- Use a hitch lock- this makes it more time consuming for thieves to steal your trailer
- Park your trailer in a well-lit area- most criminals do not want to be seen committing crimes
- You can also park your trailer in an area such as a fenced backyard or garage
- Make sure you have the license plate or registration information written down
- Mark your trailer with identifiable marks
- Block the tires with tire blocks or cinder blocks
- Lock your wheels
- Remember, if you see something, say something
