AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

DATE	TIME	LOCATION	NEIGHBORHOOD
10/15/2021	2340	1025 SHROYER RD	PATTERSON PARK
SYNOPSIS: Known suspect ran into the victim intentionally after an argument.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim's husband, who provided some more information. The victim advised that she no longer wished to pursue charges.			

RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

DATE	TIME	LOCATION	NEIGHBORHOOD
10/12/2021	1615	17 CAHO ST	TWIN TOWERS
SYNOPSIS: Known suspect forced entry into the victim's residence through the front door by breaking the glass. The suspect then pointed a handgun at the victim before fleeing the scene. The suspect was arrested a few streets over.			
CASE STATUS: Detective interviewed the suspect, who was subsequently transported to the Juvenile Justice Center without incident.			
10/14/2021	0300	992 CREIGHTON AV	LINDEN HEIGHTS
SYNOPSIS: Known suspect damaged numerous vehicles on the block where the victim lives. The suspect was mad at the victim for closing his business and causing the suspect to become unemployed, so he attempted to enter the victim's residence. This was caught on video.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who stated that he had already cleaned up the mess and that he would forward the video of the incident.

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the victim's residence through an unsecured window and stole numerous items before exiting out the rear door.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who provided several names of people that the victim believed may have done this. This is similar to several incidents.

SYNOPSIS: Known suspect changed the locks on the victim's residence and moved his stuff onto the front porch since the victim did not have a lease to be staying at the property. It was explained to the suspect that the victim has been living there for months, so he has established residency.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who stated that he would rather take the victim to small claims court to get the money back for the stolen items.

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect(s) broke into the victim's apartment and stole numerous electronics. Possible suspect information was provided to the detective.			
CASE STATUS: Detective checked LeadsOnline and was met with negative results. Detective made contact with the victim, who advised that he was going to contact the company he rented the Xbox from to get the serial number.

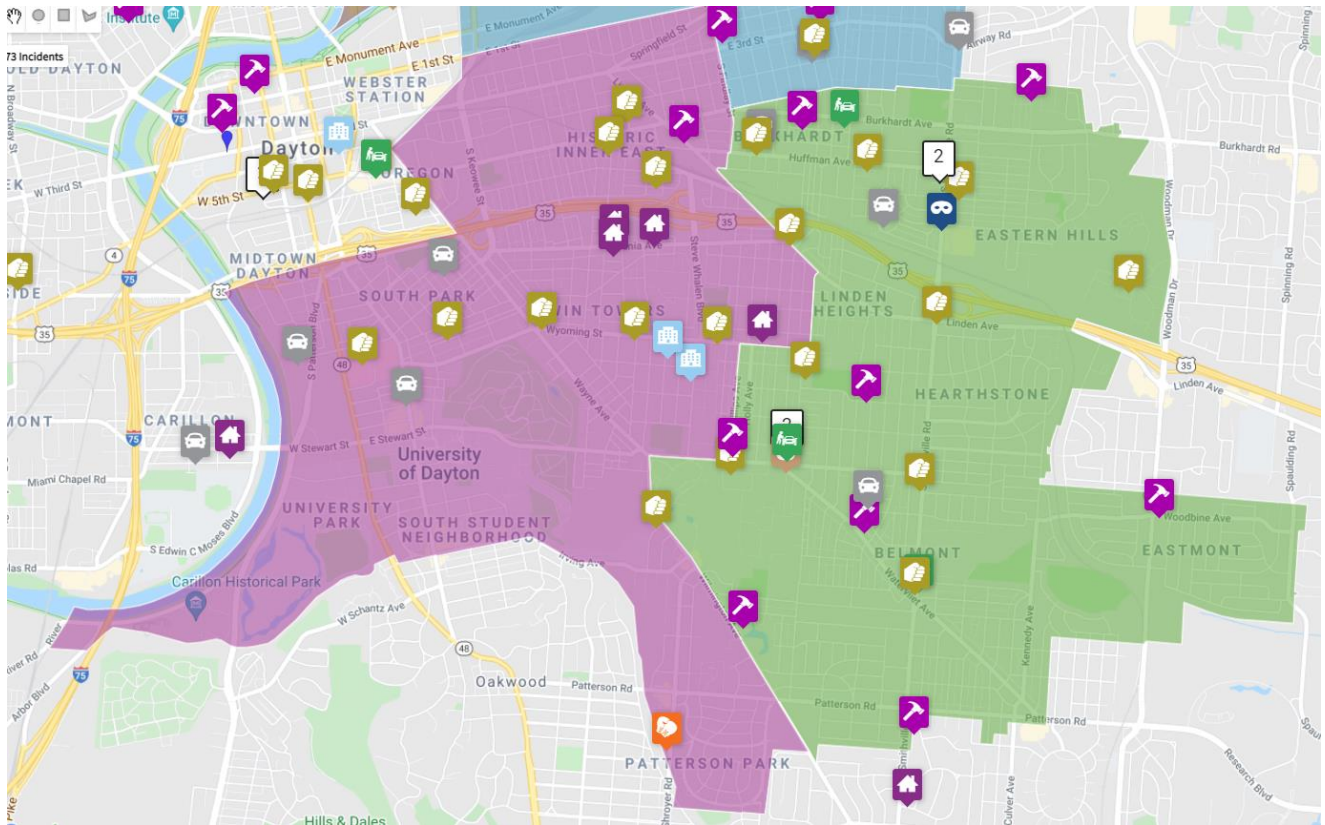
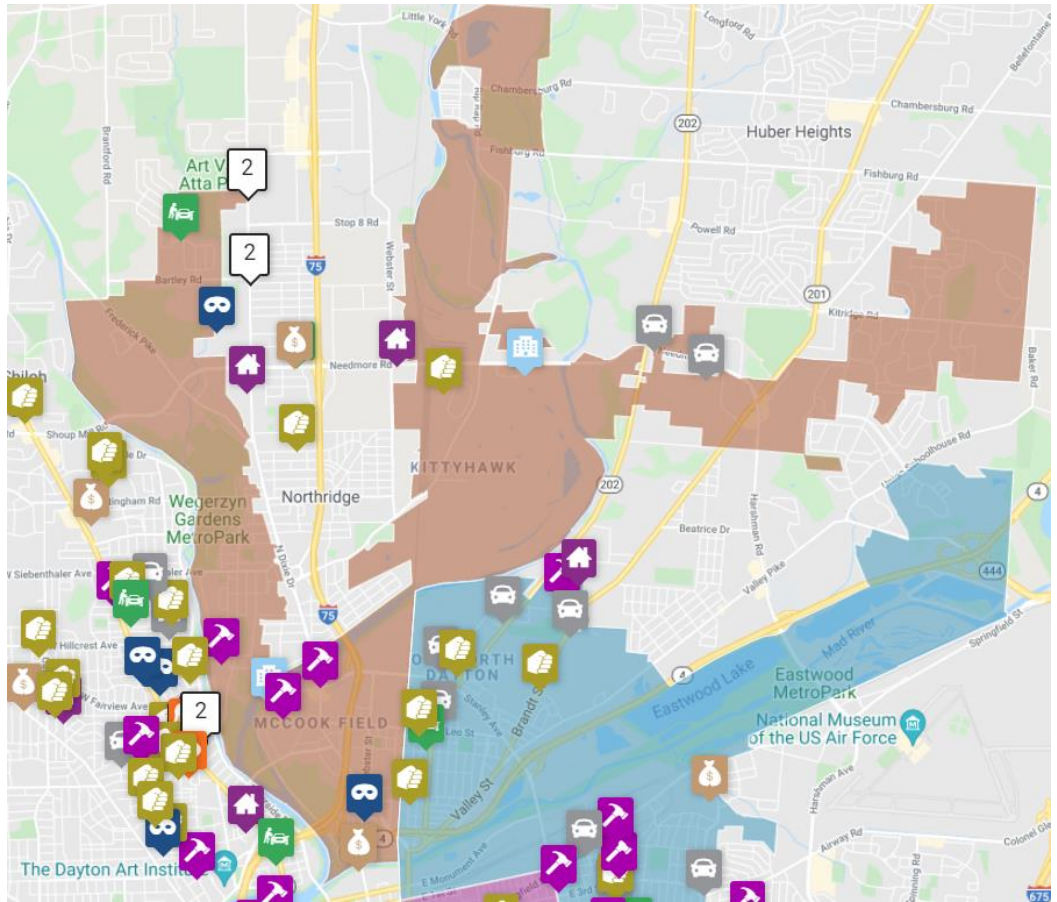
Upcoming COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics
