SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the store, grabbed the victim by the hair, and forced her to open the register. The suspect then fled the scene.

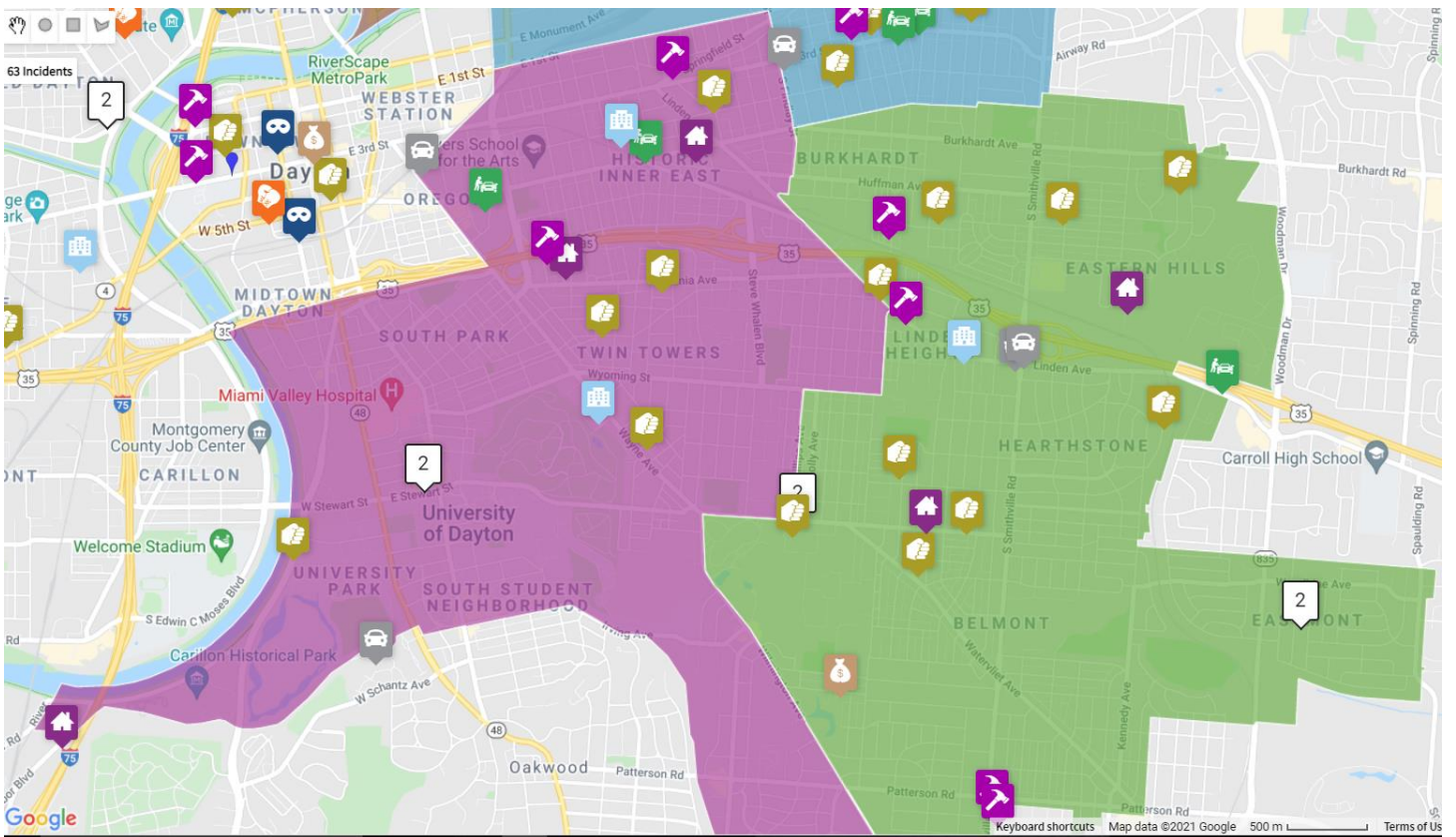
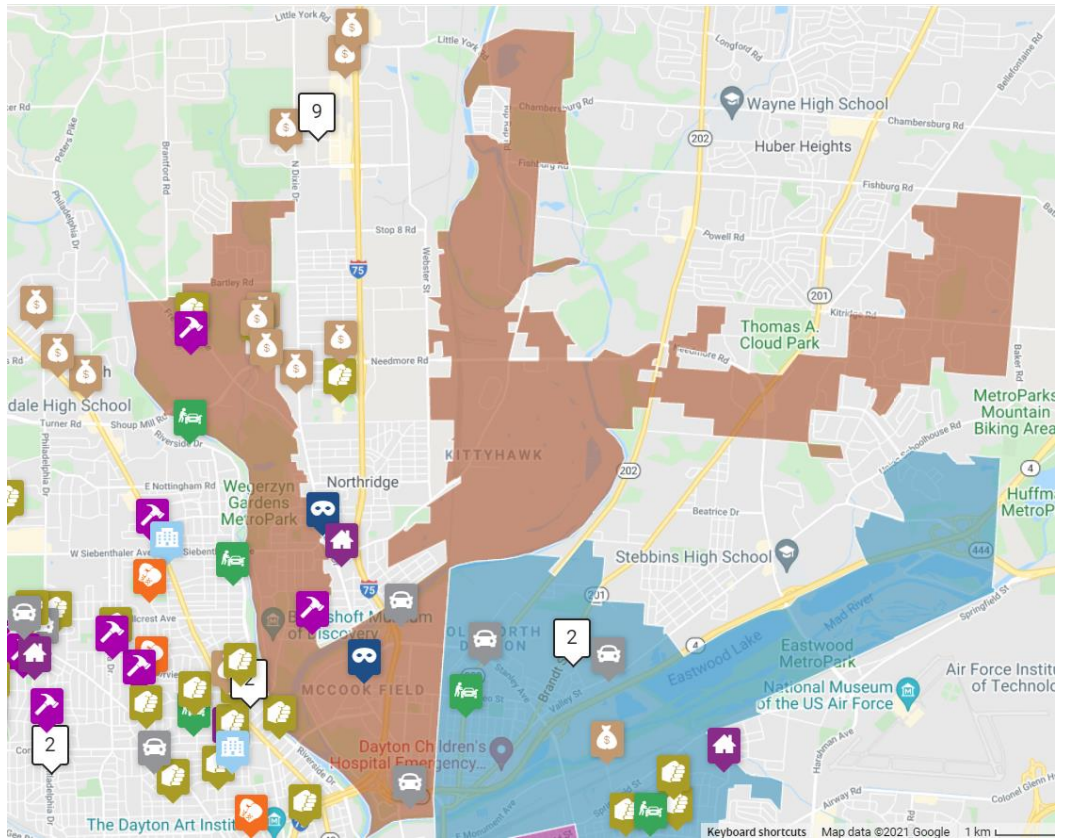
