AGGRAVATED ROBBERY

DATE	TIME	LOCATION	NEIGHBORHOOD
11/4/2021	1915	200 CLOVER ST	TWIN TOWERS
SYNOPSIS: The victim was standing next to his scooter when three unknown suspects approached him from behind. Two of the suspects produced handguns. The victim gave the suspects \$7 and his cellphone, which was later recovered.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who clarified some details.			
11/4/2021	1925	1 BOLTIN ST	HISTORIC INNER EAST
SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect approached the victim as the victim was walking home and demanded items. When the victim refused, the suspect produced a handgun. The suspect hit the victim in the head with the gun causing the victim into compliance and he emptied his pockets. The suspect then fled the scene.			
CASE STATUS: No detective supplementary report entered at this time.			
11/4/2021	1930	3200 E THIRD ST	BURKHARDT
SYNOPSIS: Two known suspects pulled up in front of the victim, who was walking near the Dollar General. One of the suspect's exited the vehicle and approached the victim, carrying a knife or handgun (the victim is unsure.) The victim was told to remove his jacket and run away, which he did.			
CASE STATUS: Detectives checked the cameras in the area, which led to negative results in capturing the robbery.			

ROBBERY

SYNOPSIS: Two unknown juveniles attempted to steal the victim's vehicle that was left unlocked and running with the keys in the ignition. The victim left her two children in the vehicle. The victim's son grabbed the driver, who lost control and crashed into the shrubbery on the other side of the lot. The suspects then exited the vehicle and fled the scene.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the store in an attempt to retrieve the possible video footage of this incident. Detective made contact with the victim, who reviewed what happened at the gas station.			

RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the victim's unsecured residence and stole miscellaneous clothing items, purses, wallets, and cash.			
CASE STATUS: Detective attempted to make contact with the victim, but was met with negative results.

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the victim's apartment without 24 hours notice to do work and stole miscellaneous items. The landlord is not being forthcoming with the name of the maintenance man that entered the property.			
CASE STATUS: Detective attempted to make contact with the victim, but was met with negative results. The detective made contact with a neighbor that has video footage of this incident that was provided to the detective.			

BREAKING AND ENTERING

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the vacant property the victim's company just purchased and damaged a window along with two doors. The inside of the building was destroyed by the suspects.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who confirmed what was damaged and when it may have happened along with some electronic items that were stolen.

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspects damaged the rear door to the noted property and stole a water heater. It is unknown if anything else was missing at that time. There are pry marks, but it appears a window was broken out in order to gain entry to the property.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who advised there were cameras on the property and that the detective needed to contact the property manager to get details on pricing for fixing the damage.

SYNOPSIS: Two men damaged the front door by throwing a rock through it. They then entered the store and stole several items before fleeing the scene.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who had video footage ready for pickup from this incident. Detective checked Carl's Body Shop next door regarding this incident as well.

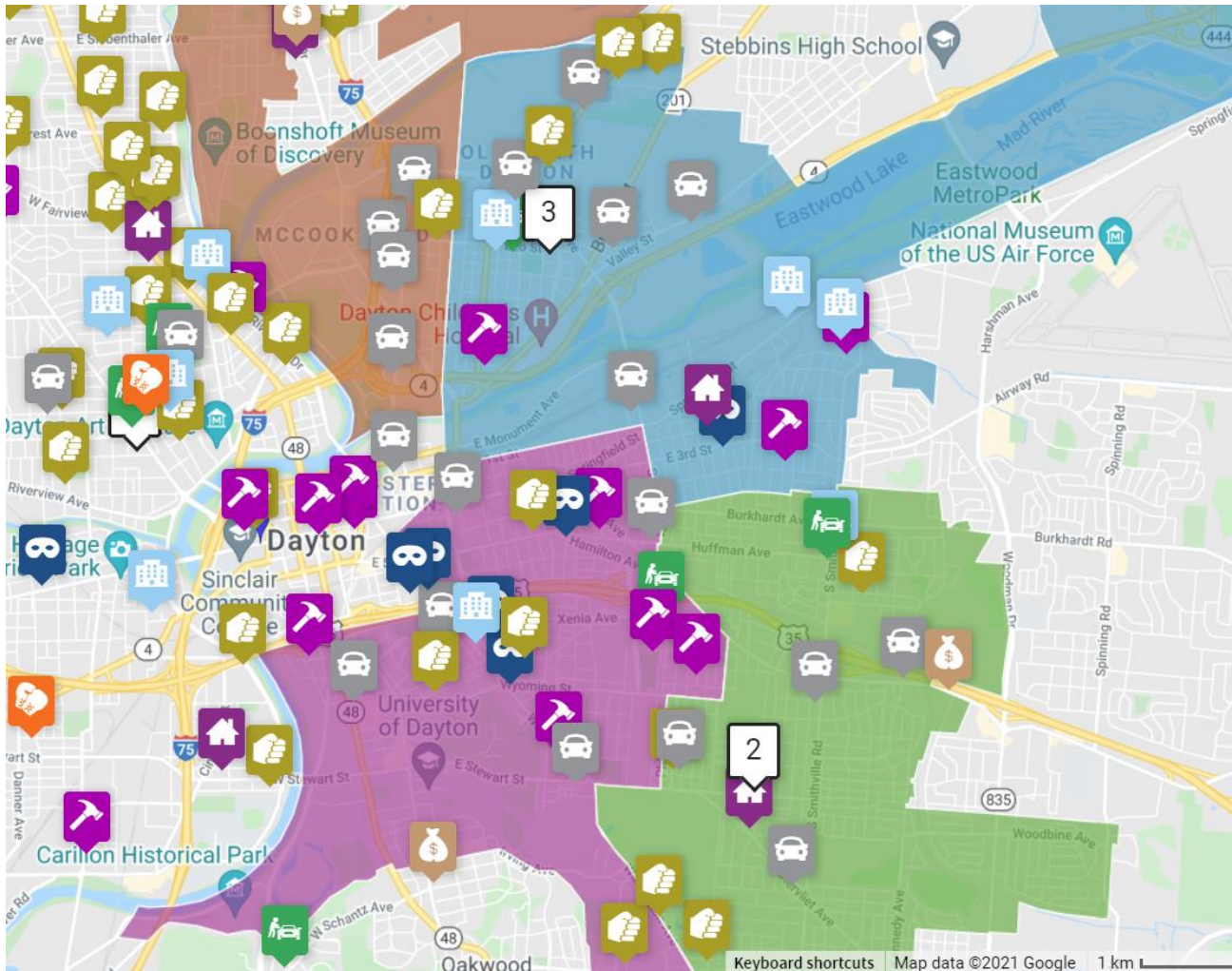
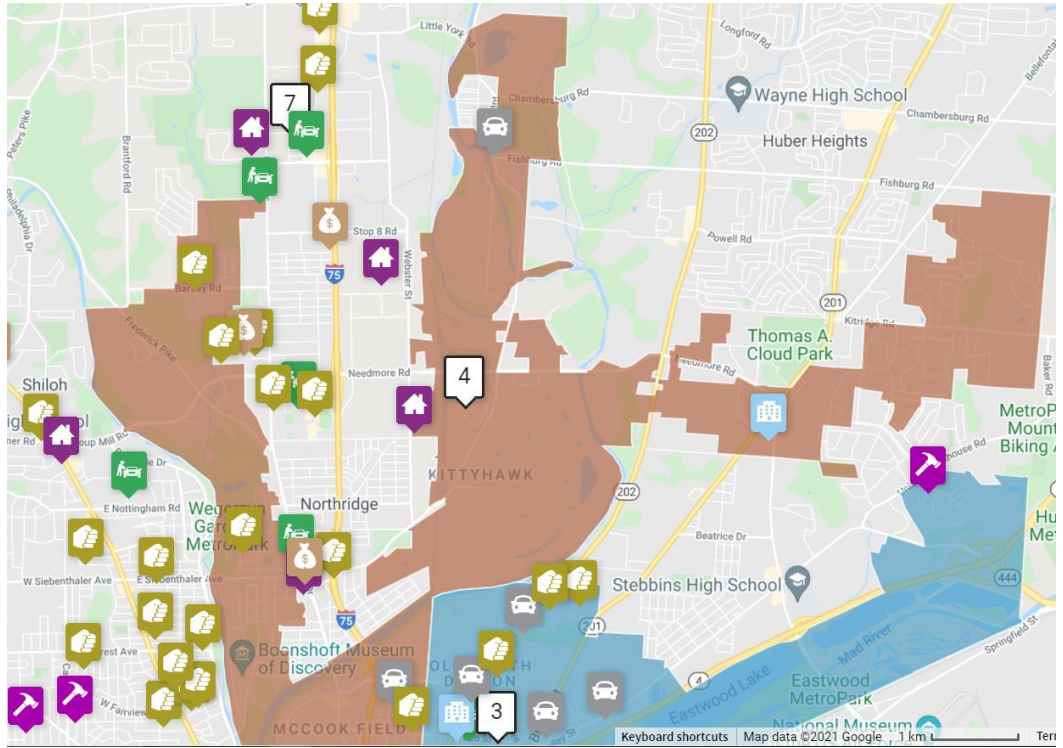
