AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

SYNOPSIS: The victim and the known suspect got into a physical argument. The suspect drug the victim throughout the residence. The victim wanted to leave, but the suspect would not let her. After a short time, she was able to get away in her vehicle.

CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim to clarify some details.

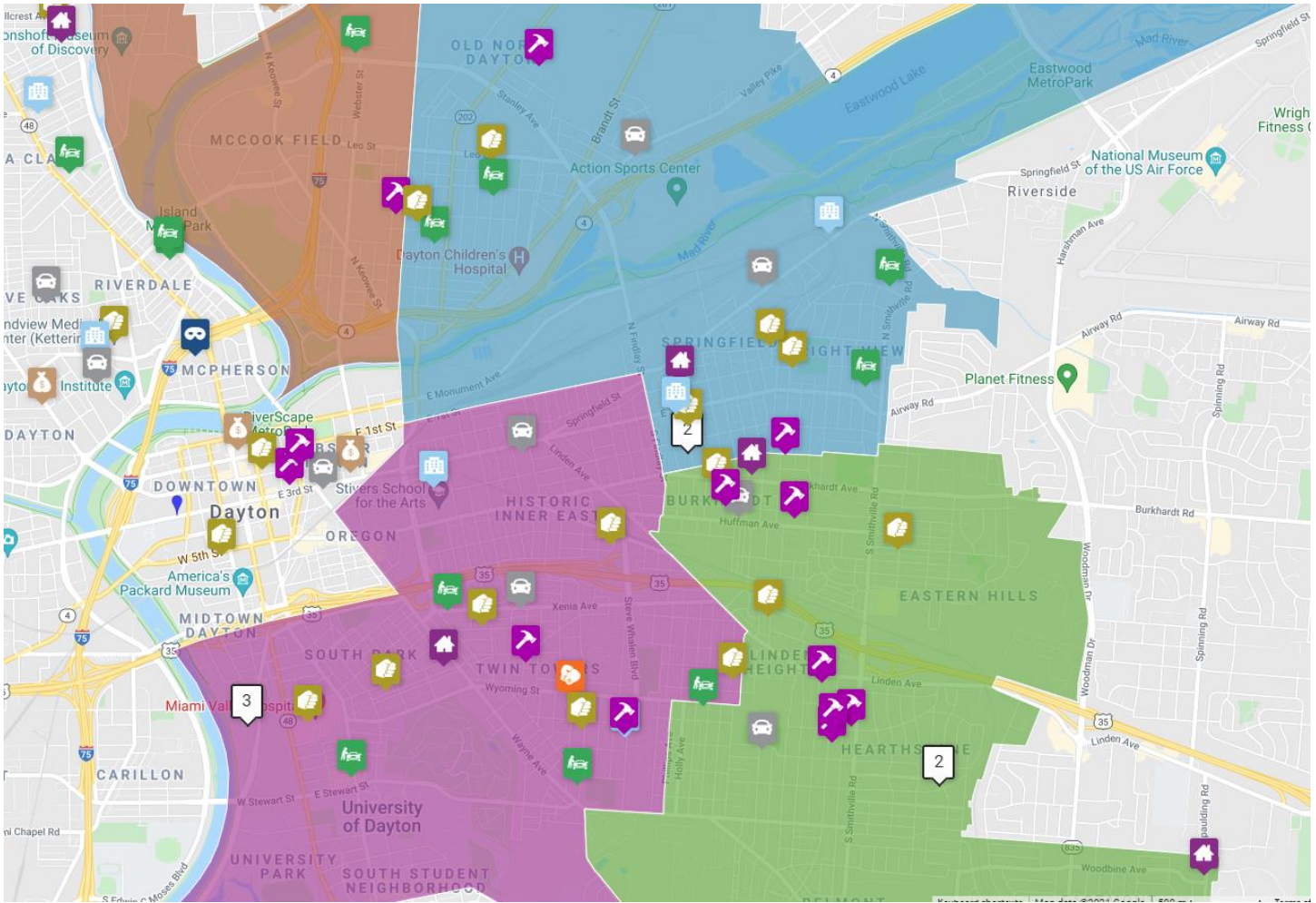
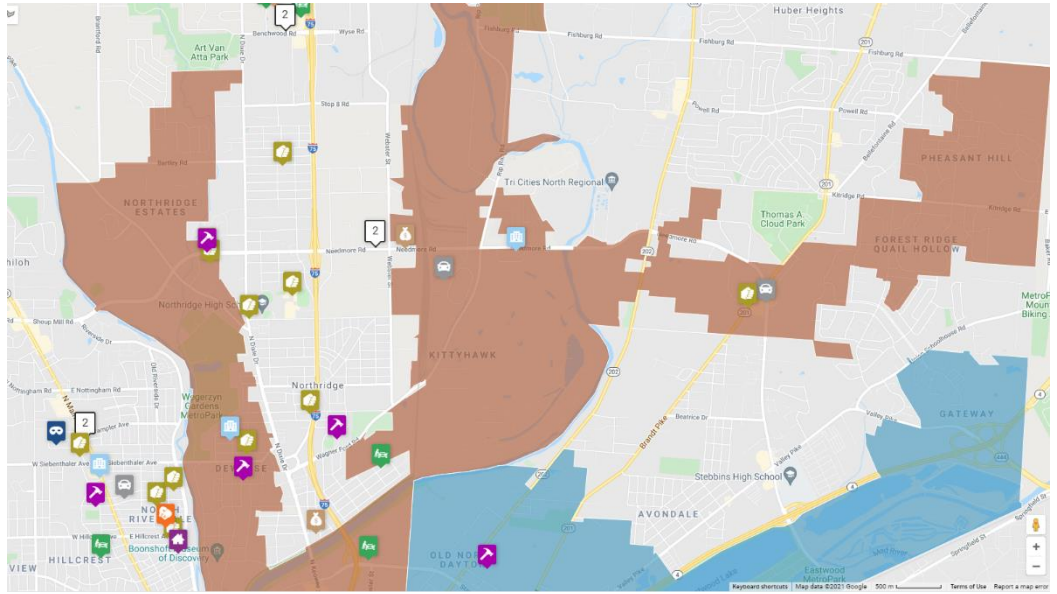
