AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

DATE	TIME	LOCATION	NEIGHBORHOOD
12/18/2021	1925	299 S SMITHVILLE RD	WRIGHT VIEW
SYNOPSIS: Known suspect struck the rear end of the victim's vehicle while accelerating. The suspect's vehicle pushed the victim's vehicle over the curb and into a hill, causing his vehicle to flip. The suspect was arrested on scene.			
CASE STATUS: Charges were presented to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office and approved.			

ROBBERY

12/17/2021	0534	107 BIG PINE RD	EASTERN HILLS
SYNOPSIS: Two unknown suspects attempted to steal the victim's vehicle that was left unlocked and running with the keys in the ignition. The vehicle crashed into a fence and the suspects fled the scene.			
CASE STATUS: Detective was able to make contact with the victim, who recounted what happened.			

RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the victim's residence and stole three televisions.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who had no new information to provide. This incident was not caught on camera. LeadsOnline was searched for the stolen property, but was met with negative results.

SYNOPSIS: Known suspect kicked in the door to the victim's residence and pointed a gun at him. The victim advised the suspect believes he owes him money. The suspect fled the scene with the victim's wallet, cellphone, and gun.			
CASE STATUS: Charges were presented to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office and approved. The suspect was arrested on December 18 th , 2021 and transported to the Montgomery County Jail.

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the rear patio area of the victim's residence through an unlocked door. When the suspect noticed the victim was home, the suspect fled the scene. This incident was caught on video.			
CASE STATUS: Detective attempted to make contact with the victim, but was met with negative results.

SYNOPSIS: The victim and the suspect got into an argument at the mall earlier in the day. When they returned home, the victim and a friend entered the noted address while the suspect was left outside. A short time later, the suspect kicked in the victim's door and the victim shot the suspect. The victim does not wish to pursue charges.			
CASE STATUS: Charges were presented to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office and refused.

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the victim's detached garage and stole a charger to the victim's lawn mower along with some miscellaneous tools and clothing items.			
CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who advised that this incident was not caught on camera and that none of the neighbors witnessed this incident.			

MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT

SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect was given a ride by the victim. After the victim realized the suspect was too high, he dropped him off where he picked him up. When the suspect went to get out of the vehicle, he grabbed the victim's wallet and fled the scene.			
CASE STATUS: Detective was provided with video footage of this incident. The suspect was later identified and arrested without incident. The victim advised that he no longer wished to pursue charges against the suspect.

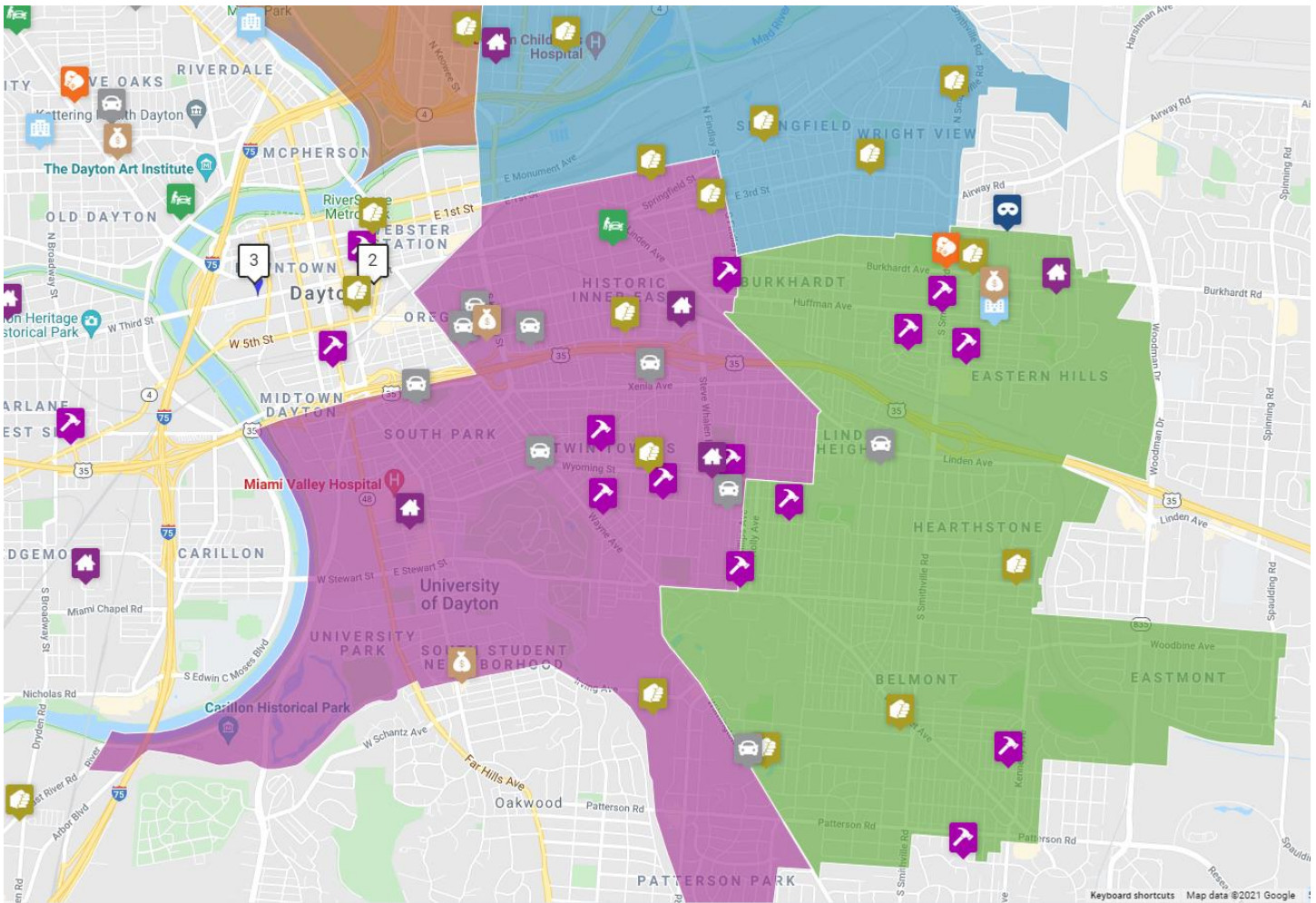
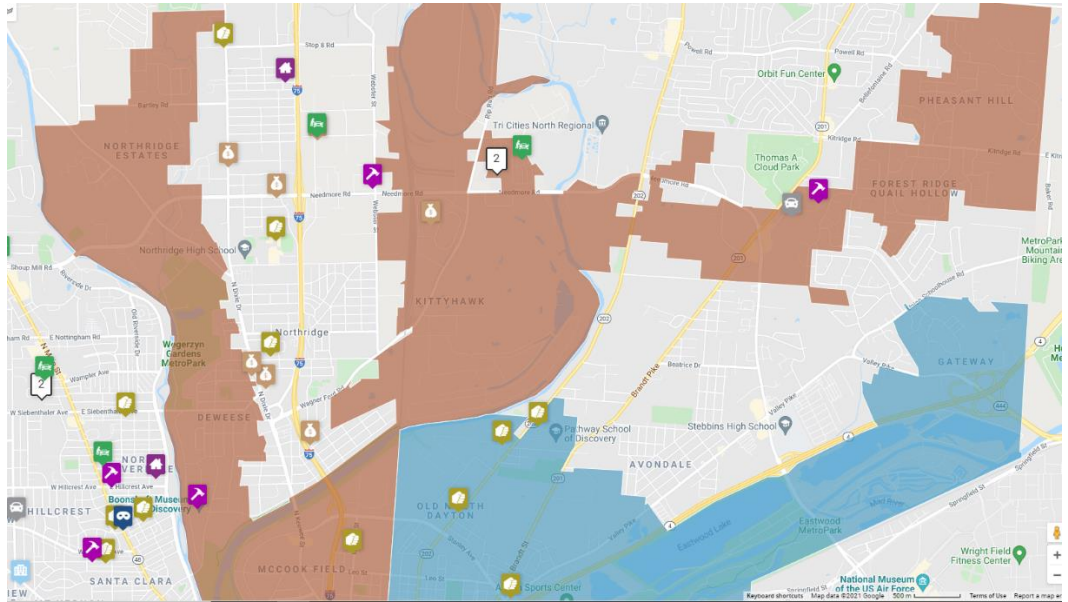
