AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

SYNOPSIS: Known suspects assaulted the victim as he was exiting his vehicle in front of his residence. The suspects punched the victim and one pointed a gun at him. This was over the victim telling one of the female suspects that she was no longer allowed to have drug addicts inside the residence. The suspects were arrested the following day and transported to the Montgomery County Jail.

CASE STATUS: Charges were presented to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office and marked for further investigation.



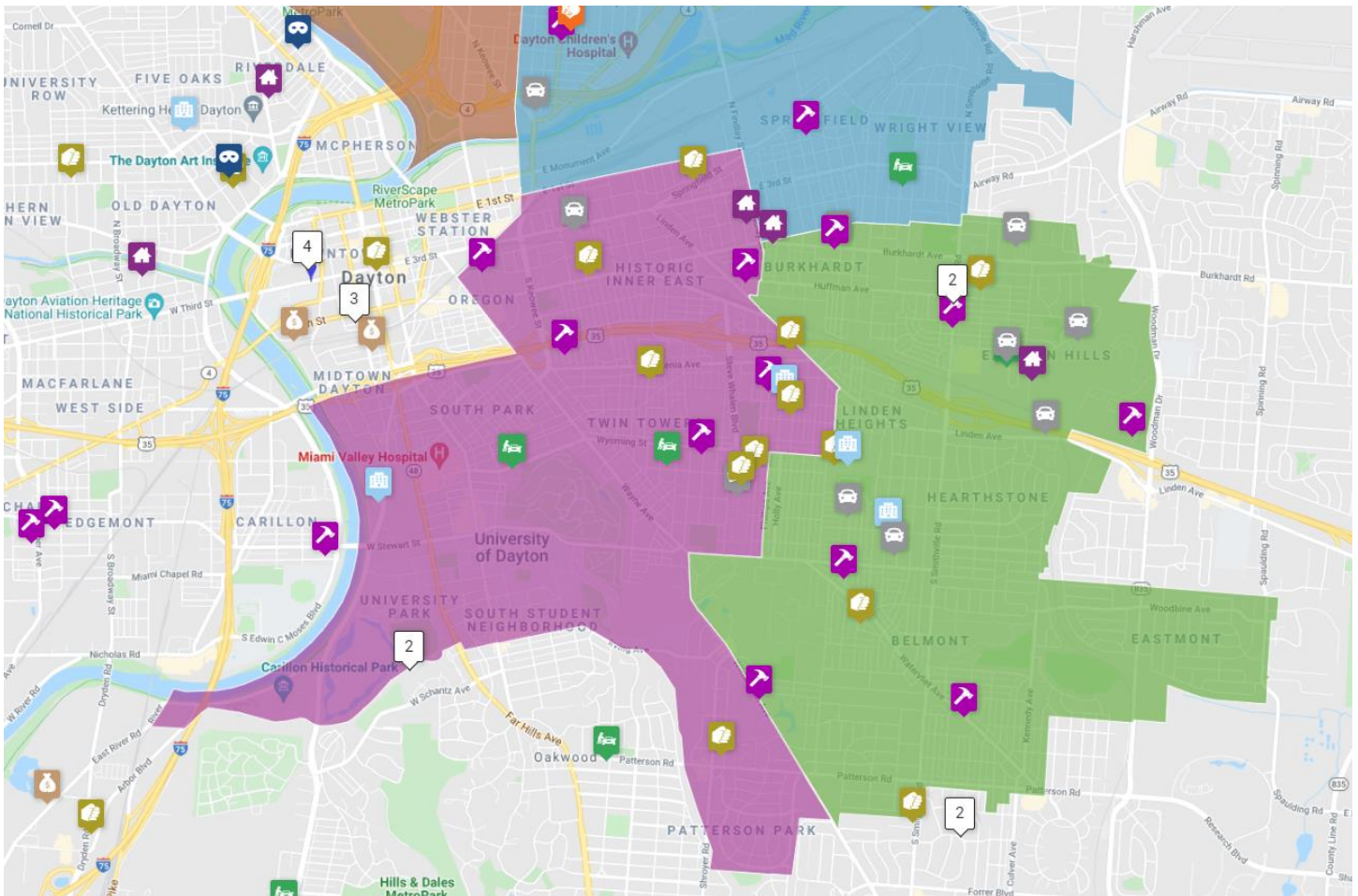
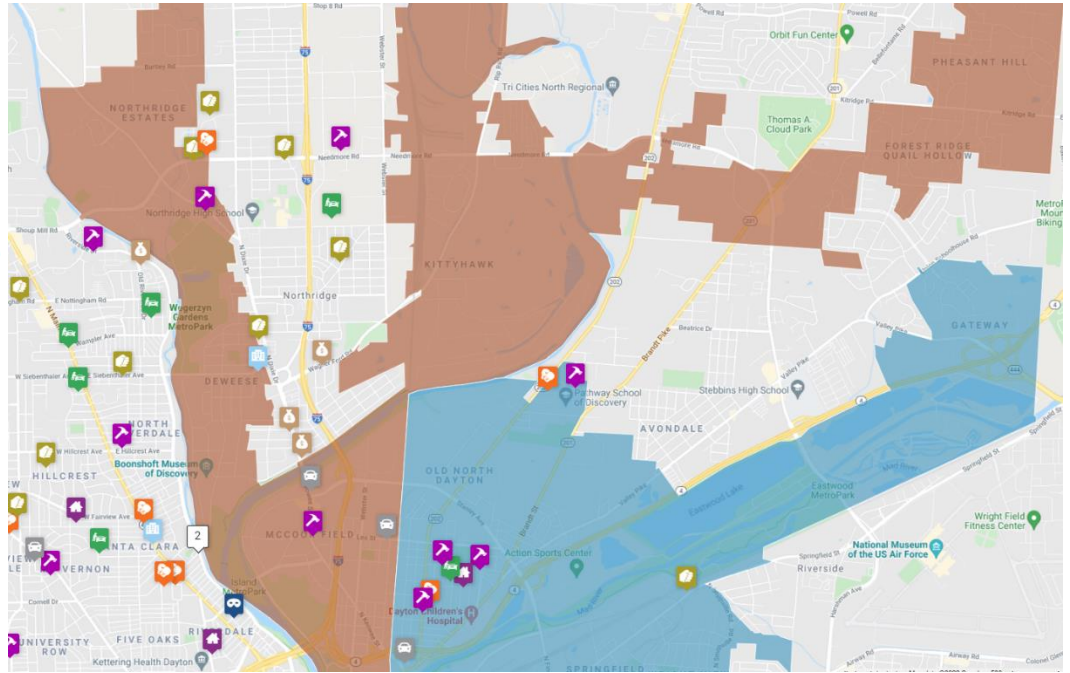
