CASE STATUS: Detective spoke with the victim and advised him that they had the suspect on video footage from the casino. The suspect was identified.			

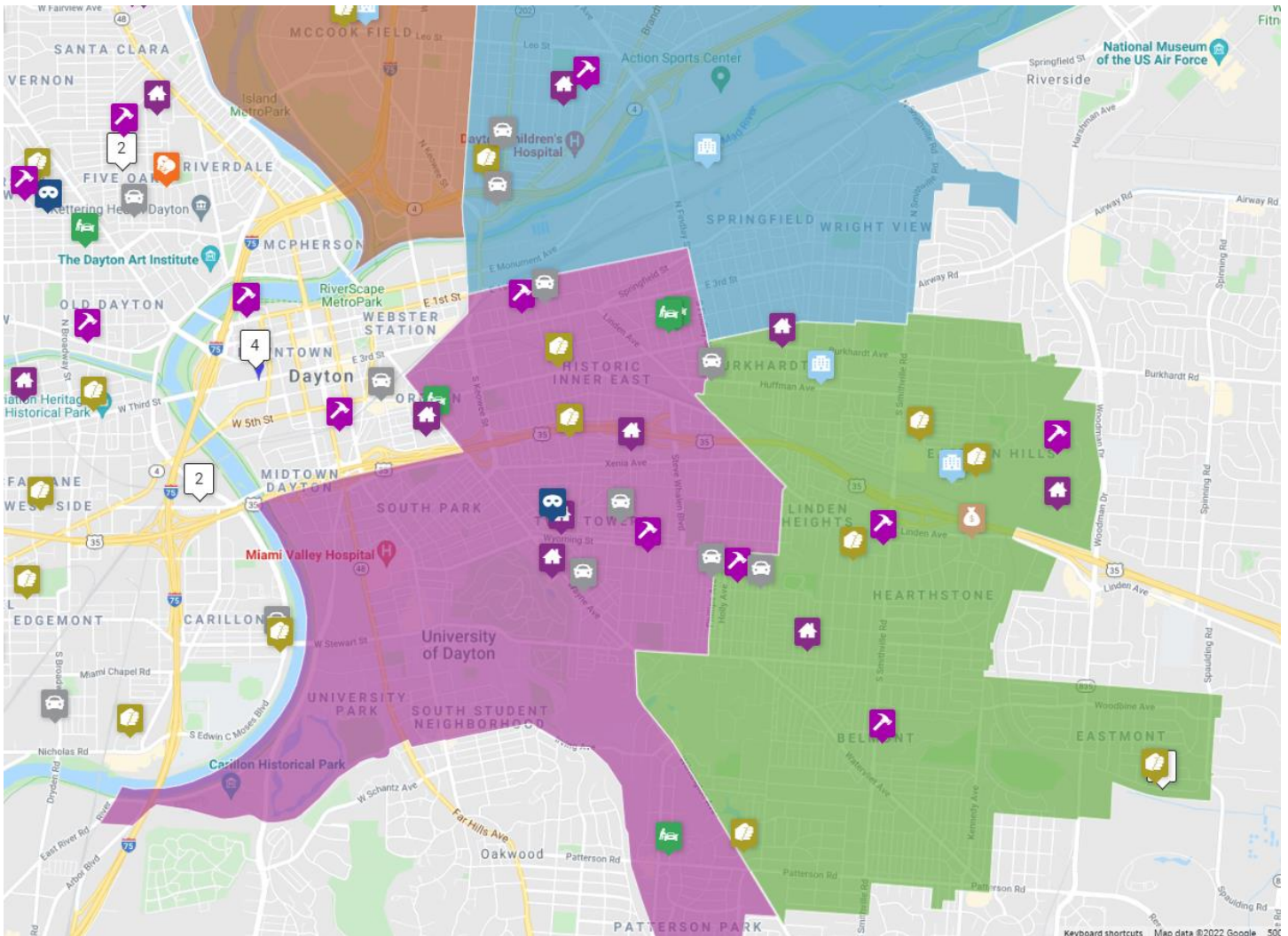
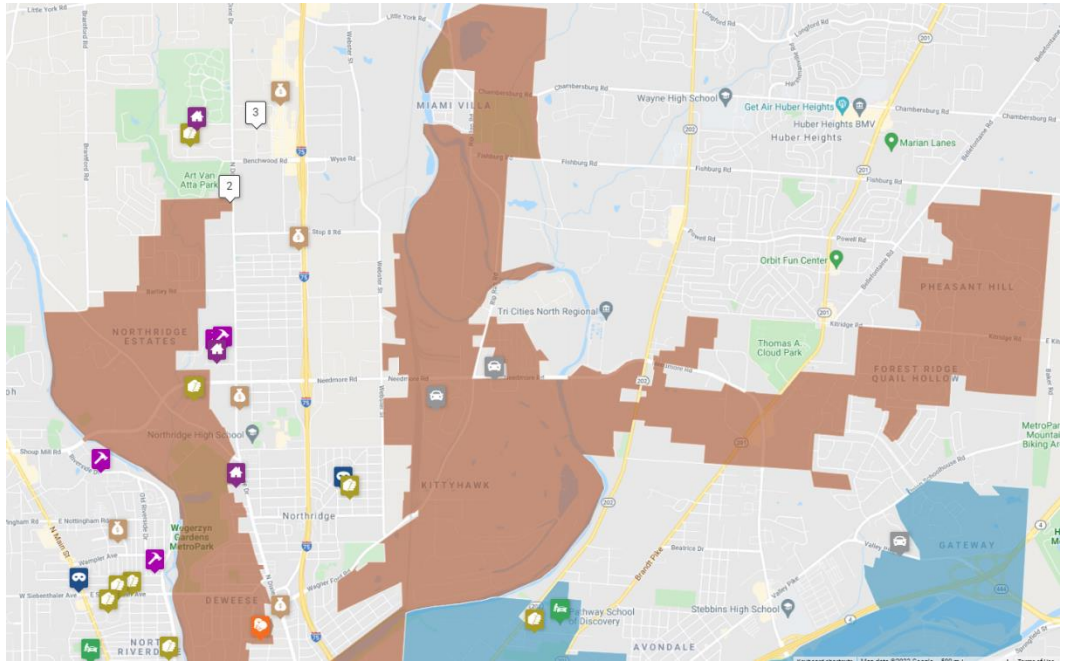
