AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

SYNOPSIS: The victim was trying to identify the suspect as he was causing issues with one of the apartments. When the victim was walking around the front of the vehicle, the suspect hit the gas and struck the suspect. Right before the suspect fled onto Needmore Road, the victim let go of the hood and the suspect fled. Victim was transported to Miami Valley Hospital for treatment.

CASE STATUS: No detective supplementary report entered at this time.

SYNOPSIS: Three unknown suspect agreed to meet the victim as the victim was attempting to sell some Nike brand shoes. The victim grabbed two of the pairs of shoes, but one of the suspect's pepper sprayed him in the face before fleeing the scene with the third pair of shoes. This incident was caught on video.

CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who gave a consistent statement about what happened along with descriptions of the suspects.

<p>SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect entered the victim's residence and then fled the scene. The suspect was arrested a short time later and transported to the Montgomery County Jail. There is possible video footage of part of this incident.</p> <p>CASE STATUS: Charges were presented to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office and approved.</p>

<p>SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect cut the lock off the victim's detached garage and made entry.</p> <p>CASE STATUS: Detective made contact with the victim, who advised nothing was missing and he had no suspect information at this time.</p>			
1/11/2022	1800	149 VIRGINIA AV	WALNUT HILLS
<p>SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect cut the lock off the victim's detached garage and damaged the wooden interior door frame of the garage. There were no cameras in the area that would have caught this incident on video.</p> <p>CASE STATUS: Detective attempted to make contact with the victim, but was met with negative results.</p>

<p>SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect named "Rob the Robber" stole the victim's car keys off her table after she invited him back to her house after drinking too much. Officers were able to locate a possible suspect.</p> <p>CASE STATUS: No detective supplementary report entered at this time.</p>

<p>SYNOPSIS: Unknown suspect stole the victim's vehicle that was left unlocked and running with the keys in the ignition while it was warming up. The detective met with a neighbor that had ring video footage of this incident, but was waiting on the footage to be put onto a flash drive.</p>

An unknown suspect stole the victim's vehicle.</p> <p>CASE STATUS: No detective supplementary report entered at this time.</p>

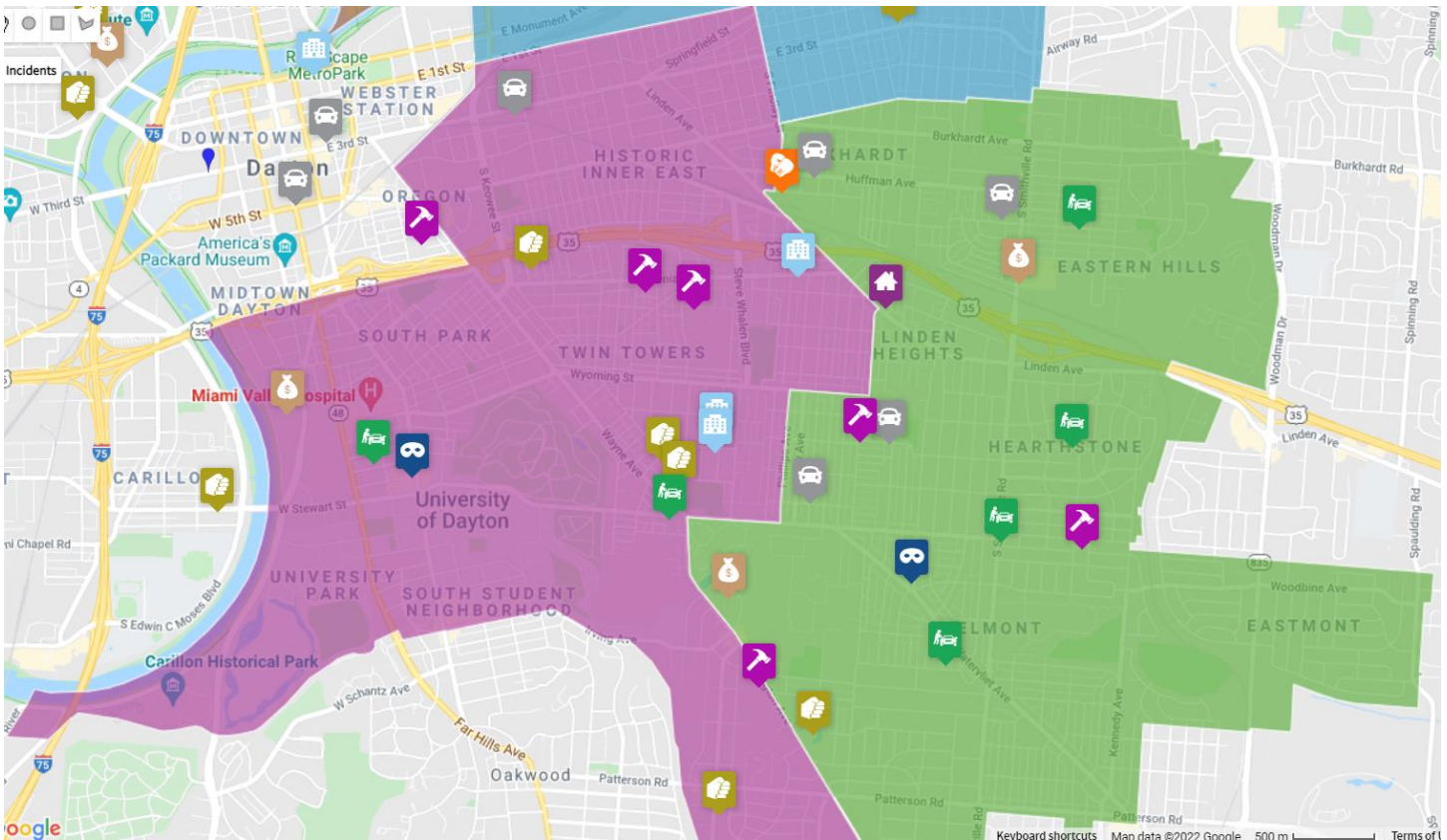
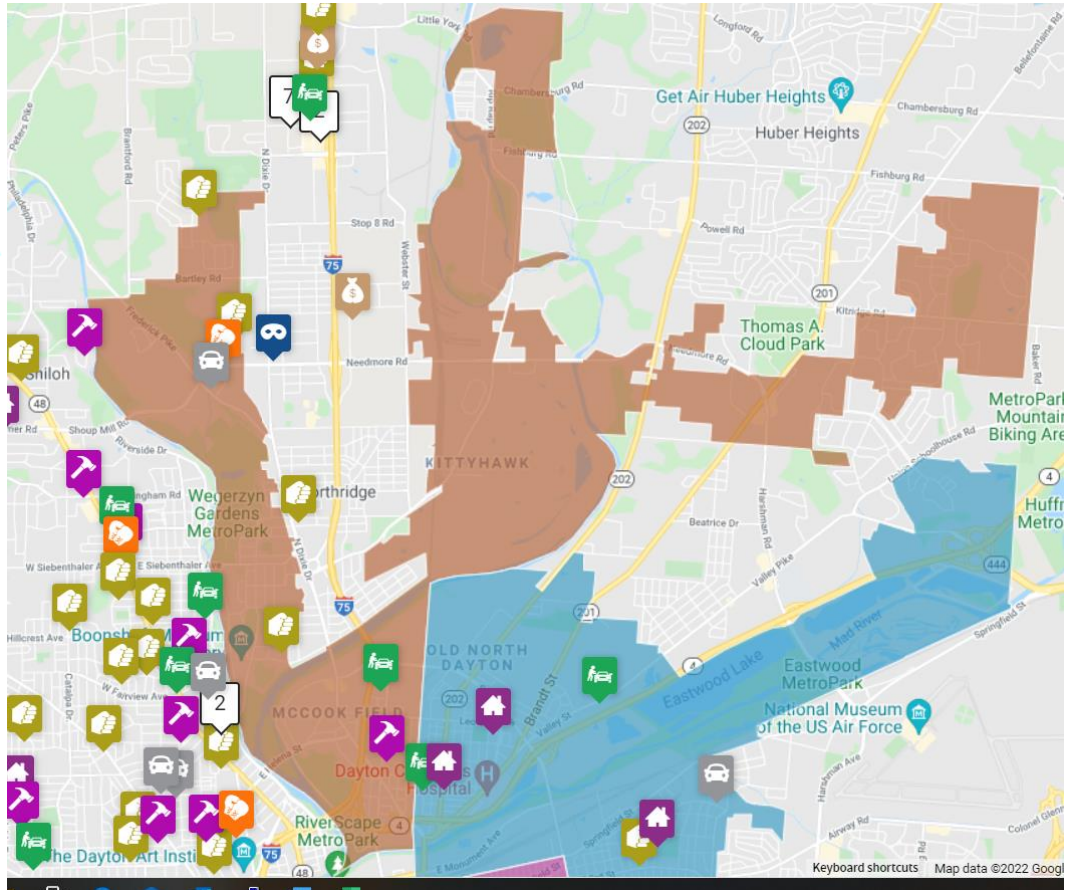
