**SYNOPSIS:** The victim was seated in a rear seat on the bus. The unknown suspect approached the victim and told him to move over. At some point after this incident, the victim went to Miami Valley Hospital for treatment. The victim advised he would be able to identify the suspect and that he stays at the shelter as well.

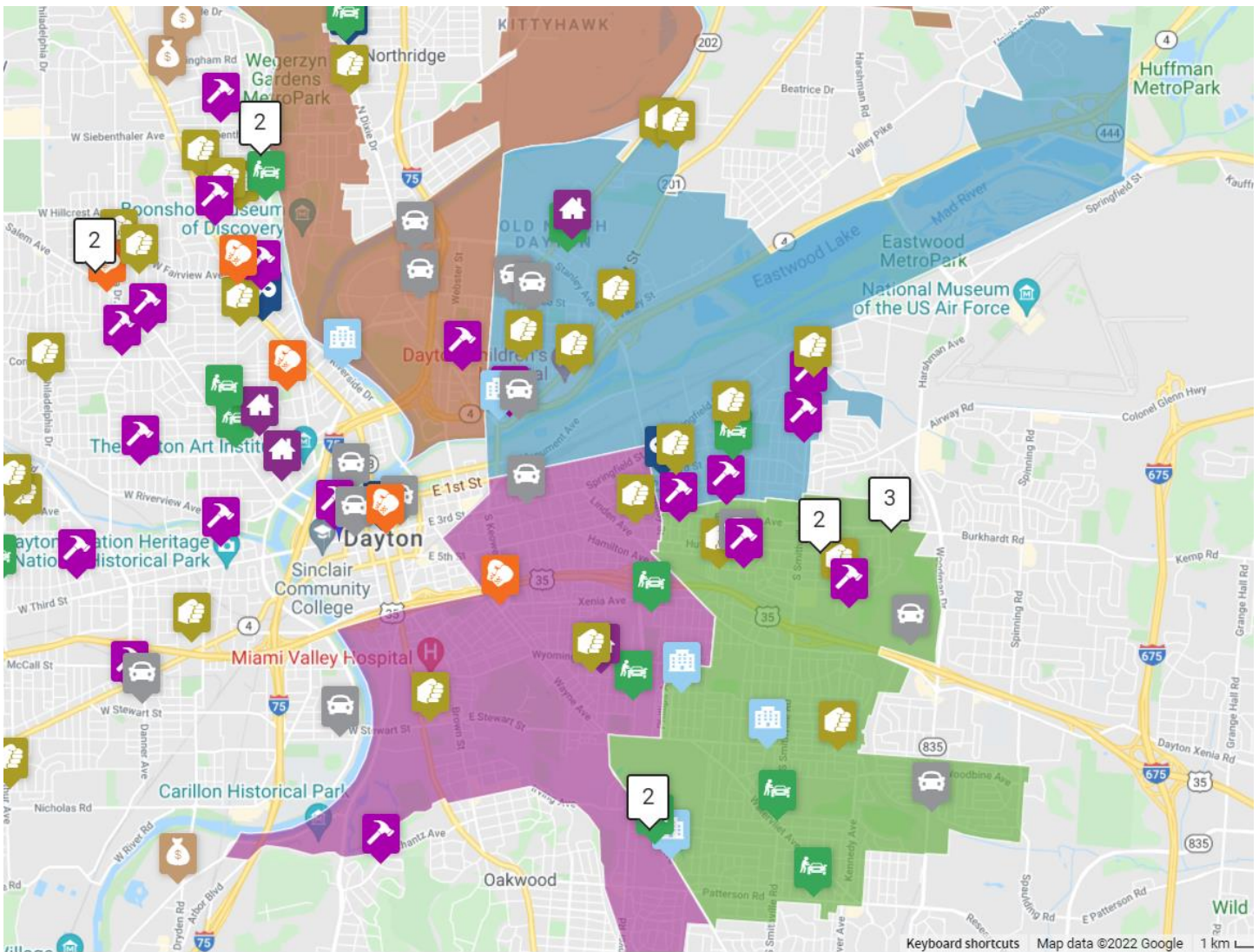
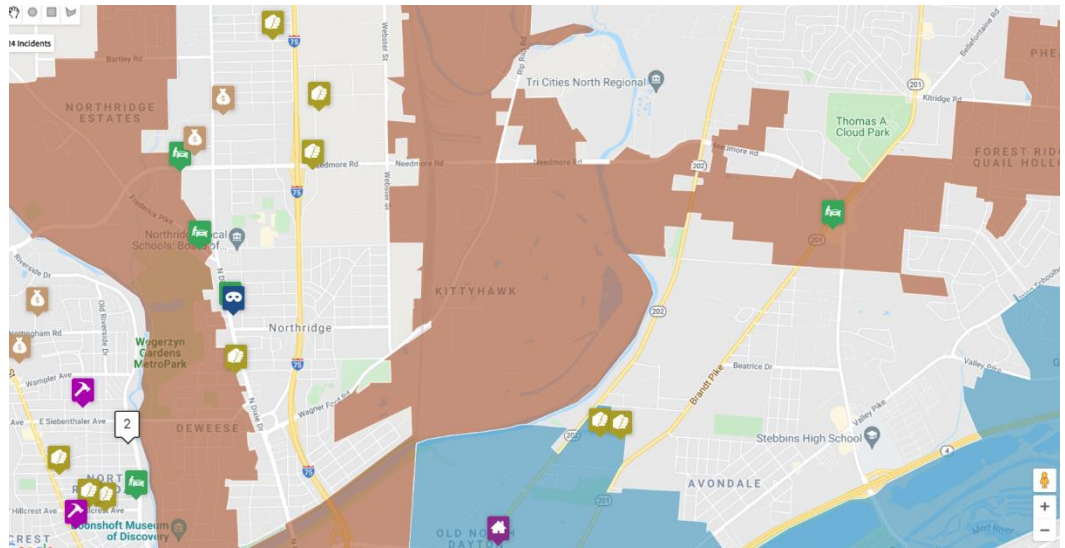
