The Dayton Police Department offers “Safe Exchange Zones” at each Dayton Police District located at the addresses listed above. If you are buying, selling, or trading items to an unknown individual, these are safe, well lit locations with cameras to make your transactions.

OFFER UP/LET GO/CRAIGSLIST SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS:

Due to recent robberies involving the OfferUp app, the Dayton Police Department strongly encourages you to utilize these tips whenever conducting a transaction on any of these marketplaces.

TIPS FOR SAFE BUYING/SELLING:

- Make the transaction in a public place such as a police station, fire department, or other public location. Make sure the location has a video surveillance system, and be in close proximity to the cameras when you do the transaction.
- Transact business during daylight hours.
- Make the transaction when other people will be around. Do not meet in a public place, and then follow someone to their car, or "just around the corner."
- If the deal sounds too good to be true, it probably is. Trust your gut.
- Never go to the transaction location alone. Take at least one other person with you.
- Trust your instincts. If something "doesn't feel right," leave immediately. This is not the time to worry about hurting someone's feelings. Your safety is paramount.
- If they have to leave you to "go get" something, this is a good indicator that you are about to be robbed.
- Unless the item is too large to take out of your home, never invite a buyer to your home.
- Never agree to meet a seller at their home or other residential address (unless the item is very large).
- Do not linger after the transaction. Make sure you are not being followed.
- Be very cautious when buying or selling high-value items. Meet at a police station.
- Use the app to report users who violate the terms of the marketplace.
- Report all crimes to the police.

How safe is YOUR password?

Make your passwords longer and stronger, perhaps with a phrase like “MyCowsHappyToday.” Create a random passphrase at least eight characters long – and don’t make it just a single dictionary word. The old practice of using numbers and special characters, like #, %, & or \$, made passwords complex and hard to remember. But it actually didn’t do much to prevent **brute force attacks** from software-generated consecutive guesses. The best defense for that is length. Longer passwords, no matter the characters used, are stronger – even as long as 25 characters.
