



## Human Relations Council to host Dayton Fair Housing Symposium

The Human Relations Council (HRC) will host the Dayton Fair Housing Symposium on Thursday, Oct. 27, from 10 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., at the downtown Dayton Metro Library Eichelberger Forum, 215 E. 3rd St. Doors open at 9:30 a.m. for registration.

The event will bring together housing experts from across the region to discuss issues related to health disparities and discrimination in housing, source of income as a protected class, housing as a human right, and discrimination in appraisals.

Additionally, a special session covering rights to fair housing will be held in the main forum. Speakers in attendance will include Emmy Award winner Joshua Barr, John Zimmerman of the Miami Valley Fair Housing Center, and Amaha Sellassie of Sinclair Community College.

“We are excited to host the Dayton Fair Housing Symposium at the Dayton Metro Library. The symposium will focus on the intersection of health disparities and housing, and strategies to address these issues moving forward. This event will also bring together housing specialists to address the most pressing housing concerns across the Miami Valley,” said HRC Executive Director Erica Fields.
