



Dayton Police arrest suspected serial rapist

The Dayton Police Department's Cold Case Unit, in conjunction with the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office, made an arrest on a suspected serial rapist Monday. This arrest stems from a lengthy investigation in collaboration with the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations.

These crimes occurred between 2013 to 2014, when three of the four victims were violently abused and sexually assaulted in Dayton. The fourth victim was sexually assaulted outside of Dayton.

This investigation comes almost a year after the department made significant changes to the Cold Case Unit, with its work now expanded to include both unsolved homicides and sexual assaults.

"Victims of violent crime, to include their families and loved ones, are a top priority of our department," Major Brian Johns, Commander of the Investigations Division, said. "This arrest is a direct result of the extensive work by our detectives and those from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office. My personal thanks also goes out to the great employees at the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations whose hard work and dedication led us to the arrest of this violent sexual offender."
