Detectives from the Dayton Police Department Traffic Services Unit are actively investigating a fatal hit and run in November of 2022.

On Tuesday night, November 27, 2022, at approximately 9:40 PM a male was struck in the alley behind 1939 N. Main Street. The alley runs east and west between Marathon Avenue, Richmond Avenue in Santa Clara Avenue. Unfortunately, the victim has succumbed to his injuries.

We are looking for a possible white in color 2008 to 2010 Dodge Caravan or Chrysler Town and Country. The vehicle could possibly be missing a piece of its right lower rocker bar paneling that is located directly behind the front passenger wheel and in front of the passenger door. The missing piece measures about 7"x 5".
