



## Free lifeguard training leads to certification

Lifeguard training participants can earn Red Cross certification, with free classes for those committing to work for the City of Dayton.

Lifeguard certification is available for anyone 15 years old and older through a blended learning experience, with three easy steps: Pass a skills test, complete an online course, and complete water and classroom sessions.

The two sessions are available as follows, at the Northwest Recreation Center:

Session 1 (water)

Dec 12, 13 or 14, 8 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Session 2 (classroom)

Dec. 28, 29 or 30, 8 a.m. - 3 p.m.

The \$200 training fee is waived for those going on to City of Dayton employment as lifeguards. The fee includes all needed materials and equipment. Course work and certification are issued through the American Red Cross.
