



## **Update: City Commission meeting scheduled for January 25**

Due to the forecasted weather/driving conditions, the City Commission is prepared to hold its Wednesday, Jan. 25, 8:30 a.m. meeting virtually. In order to comply with required statutory deadlines related to the annual budget appropriations, the City Commission will move forward with the scheduled public hearing in either an in-person or virtual setting. In the event of a virtual meeting, public comment will be limited to written feedback.

In order to accommodate public comment that may be hindered by poor weather conditions, the City Commission will continue to receive written comments until 5 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 30. All written comments received by the deadline will be posted online with the minutes from the Jan. 25, 2023, meeting.
