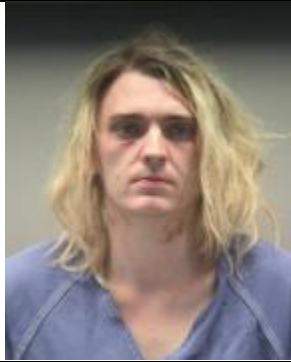

**INFORMATION UPDATES** - If the owner changes address or the vehicle or catalytic converter are stolen, it should be reported online at [www.dhsa.org](http://www.dhsa.org).

**VERIFICATION** - The secure marking and registration system provides an all-year-round, immediate verification service. This means that visiting a marked and registered item is very easy for clients to check on marked and registered items can be carried out online at [www.dhsa.org](http://www.dhsa.org) or via the QR code on the block, at any time of the day or night.

**ISR CONTACT CARD** - The vehicle owner should keep the card use of the vehicle as it may be required for future use. In the event of a theft, this should be reported by visiting [www.dhsa.org](http://www.dhsa.org). The code shown in the red box above will be required. This is the same unique number with which the catalytic converter has been marked.

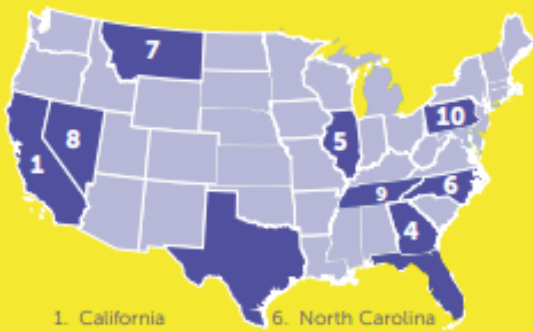

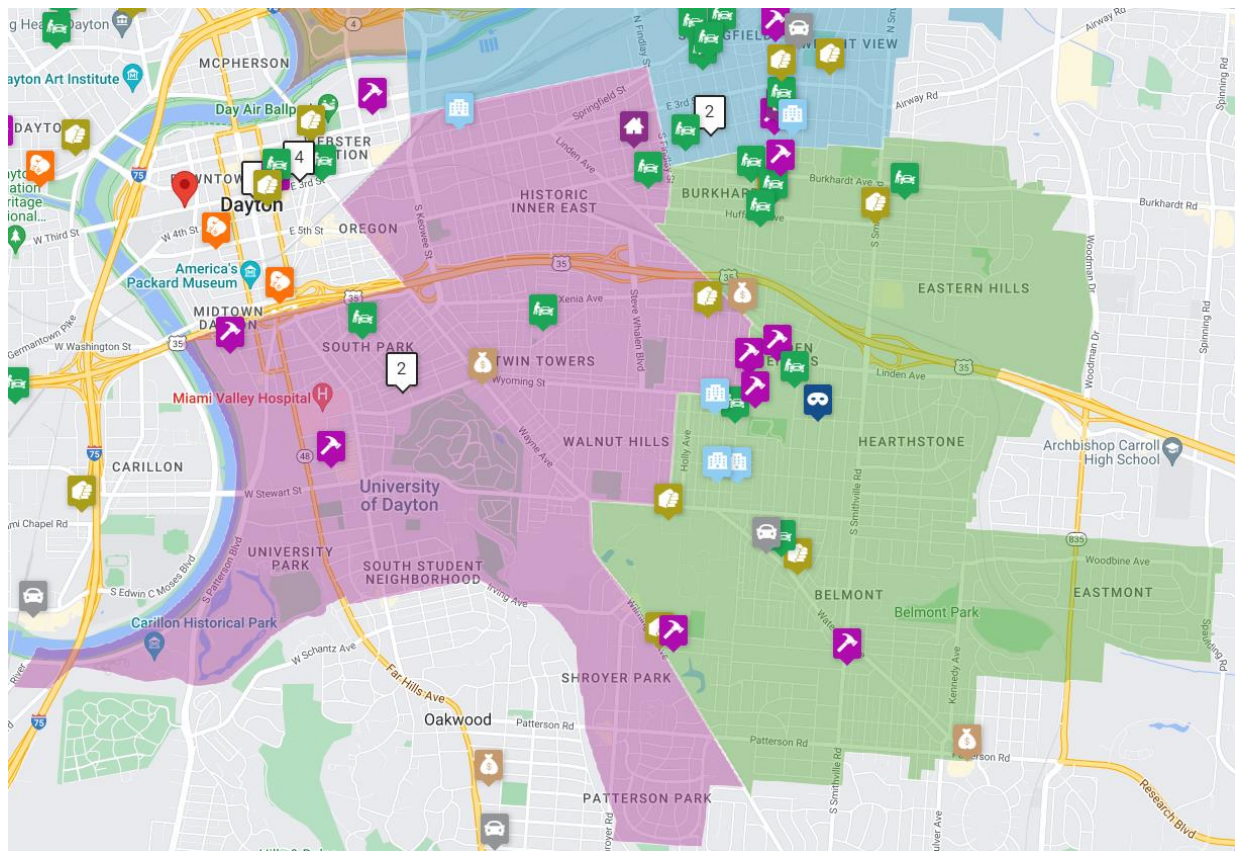
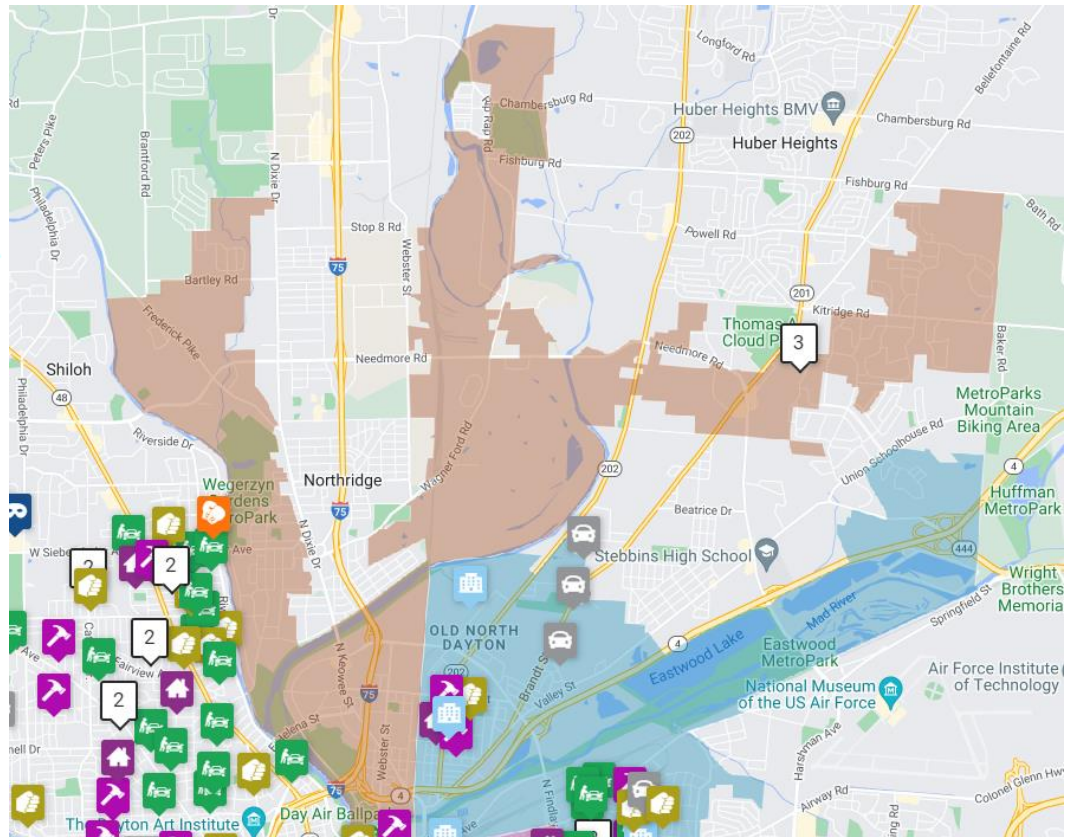
