The Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will operate two sobriety checkpoints on Thursday, March 16, in Dayton.

The checkpoints will occur between 6:30 p.m. and 11:30 p.m., in the areas of North James H. McGee Blvd. at North Gettysburg Avenue and South Keowee Street at East Fifth Street.

The OVI checkpoints and enhanced patrols around St Patrick's Day are an effort of law enforcement agencies to deter and apprehend impaired drivers. Dayton Police officers and officers of the Combined Agency OVI Task Force will conduct roadside checks of drivers for alcohol and drug impairment. The location of the checkpoints will be revealed on Thursday, March 16.

The majority of the deadliest crashes occur at the start and throughout holiday weekends. Don't Drive Impaired, and remember to Buckle Up!
