



REGISTRATION - It is very important that details of the vehicle and the owner's name and contact information are recorded on the ISR. To register go to www.dhsa.org "ISR Form" select "Catalytic Converter" then select "Registration - Catalytic Converter" or scan the QR code below.



UNIQUE CODE:



INFORMATION UPDATES - If the owner changes address or the vehicle or catalytic converter are stolen, it should be reported online at www.dhsa.org.

VERIFICATION - The secure marking and registration system provides an all-year-round, immediate verification service. This means that visiting a marked and registered item is very easy for clients to check on marked and registered items can be carried out online at www.dhsa.org or via the QR code on the block, at any time of the day or night.

ISR CONTACT CARD - The vehicle owner should keep the card use of the vehicle as it may be required for future use. In the event of a theft, this should be reported by visiting www.dhsa.org. The code shown in the red box above will be required. This is the same unique number with which the catalytic converter has been marked.

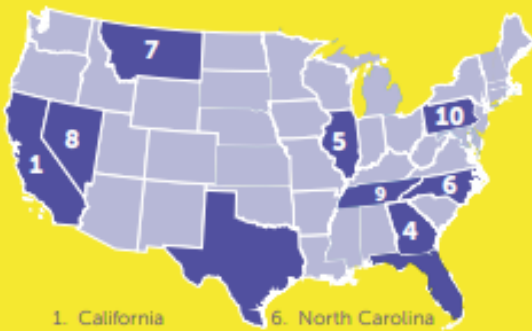
