City Manager Shelley Dickstein announces the promotion of two City of Dayton Department of Recreation staff members, effective immediately.

Stephan Marcellus is promoted to Deputy Directory of the Department of Recreation. Marcellus is a 16-year City employee, serving most recently as Recreation and Youth Services Division Manager. As Deputy Director, he will provide leadership in the management of department staff, operations, and planning, as well its approximately \$5.5 million annual budget.

Before joining the City of Dayton, Marcellus coordinated recreation and youth programs for the YMCA of Greater Dayton, among others. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Education from Wright State University and a Master of Management from Antioch University Midwest.

Lisa Barhorst is promoted to Recreation and Youth Services Division Manager. Her responsibilities will include oversight of the City's recreation centers as well as fitness and senior programming. She will also oversee aquatics, summer camps, after-school programs and special events.

Barhorst joined the City of Dayton in 2016, serving as recreation program coordinator. Previously she served as program director at the Xenia YMCA. She earned a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology from Wright State University.
