



## **City announces appointments of new division managers**

City Manager Shelley Dickstein announces three recent new hires or promotions for division manager positions.

Brian T. Cobb, CPA, is the newly appointed manager of the Division of Administration and Finance in the Department of Aviation, where he will be responsible for oversight of key activities in department and airport operations.

Cobb has extensive experience in financial and operations management for organizations in the academic, non-profit and business sectors, including Wilmington College and the Charles F. Kettering Foundation. His accomplishments include management of a \$400 million investment portfolio and oversight of financial, operations and planning activities for complex organizations. Cobb earned a M.S. in Organizational Leadership at Antioch University and a B.A. in Accounting at Olivet College.

In the Department of Planning, Neighborhoods & Development, Mike Squire has been promoted to the position of manager of the Division of Community Engagement. Squire's responsibilities include developing and managing Dayton's community engagement strategies involving residents, City staff, neighborhood associations and leaders, and community partners. He joined the City of Dayton in 2021, serving as community engagement specialist, and was previously associate vice president of resource development at United Way of the Greater Dayton Area. Squire earned a Bachelor of Arts in Communication Studies at Wright State University.

Jermaine Isaac was recently named manager of the Division of Sports in the Department of Recreation. Isaac is responsible for management of league and non-league adult and youth sports occurring at Dayton recreation centers and facilities including the Jim Nichols Tennis Center, Community Golf Club, Centennial Field and Kettering Field. Isaac worked previously as parks & recreation director for the City of Wilmington (since 2017) and was a senior recreation coordinator for the City of Dayton in 2016-17. He earned a B.S. in Sports Management Administration at Wilmington College.
