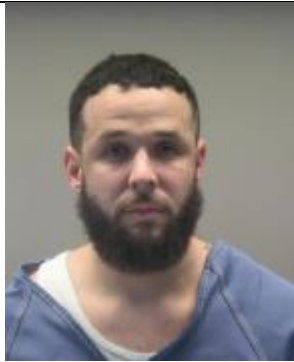

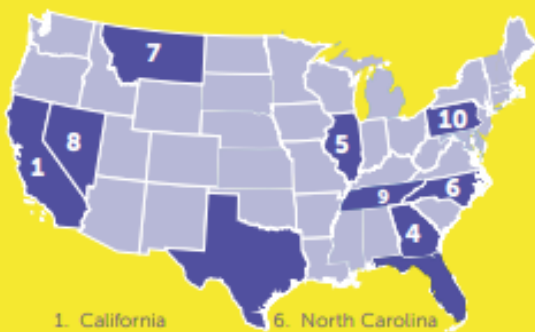

**REGISTRATION** - It is very important that details of the vehicle and the owner's name and contact information are recorded on the ISR. To register go to [www.dayton.gov](http://www.dayton.gov) "ISR Forms" select "Catalytic Converter" then select "Registration - Catalytic Converter" or scan the QR code below.



UNIQUE CODE:



**INFORMATION UPDATES** - If the owner changes address or the vehicle or catalytic converter are stolen, it should be reported online at [www.dayton.gov](http://www.dayton.gov).











**VERIFICATION** - The security marking and registration system provides an all-year-round, immediate verification service. This means that stealing a marked and registered item is very risky for thieves as checks on marked and registered items can be carried out online at [www.dayton.gov](http://www.dayton.gov) or via the QR code on the label, at any time of the day or night.

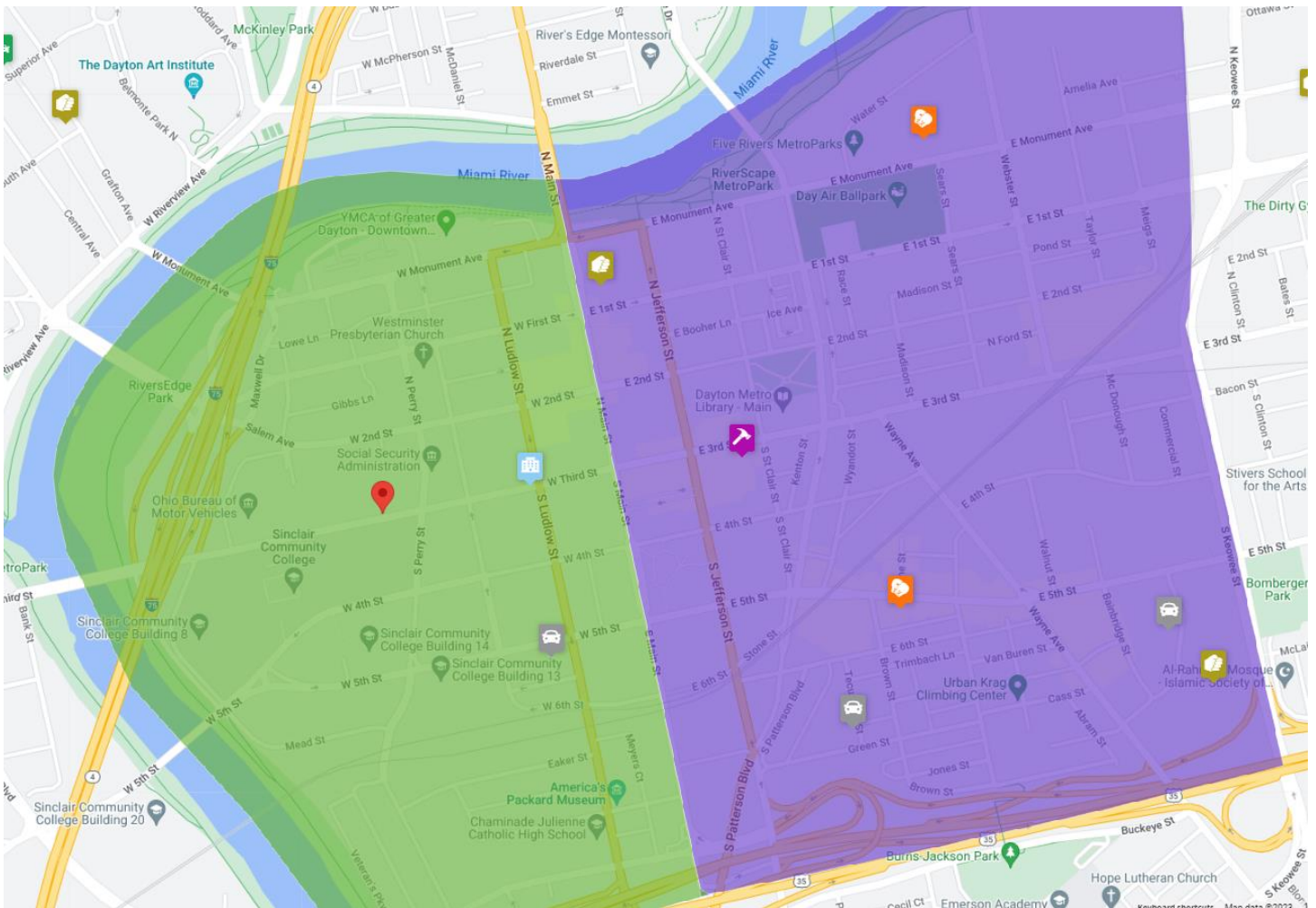
**ISR CONTACT CARD** - The vehicle owner should keep this card with the vehicle as it may be required for future use. In the event of a theft, this should be reported by visiting [www.dayton.gov](http://www.dayton.gov). The code shown in the next box should be reported. This is the same unique number with which the catalytic converter has been marked.
