The Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will operate two sobriety checkpoints in Dayton on Saturday, July 1.

The locations of the Dayton checkpoints are as follows: The first will occur in the 2300 block of Stanley Avenue, beginning at 6:30 p.m.; the second will occur in the 1400 block of Wayne Avenue and will conclude at 11:30 p.m.

Dayton Police Department officers, Ohio State Patrol troopers, Montgomery County Sheriff's Office deputies, and officers from the Combined Agency Task Force will conduct roadside checks of drivers for alcohol and drug impairment. The OVI checkpoints and enhanced patrols on and around the 4th of July weekend are an effort by law enforcement agencies to deter and apprehend impaired drivers.

The majority of the deadliest crashes occur at the start and throughout the holiday weekends. Don't drive impaired, and remember to buckle up!
