The Dayton Police Department and members of the Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will operate two sobriety checkpoints in the city of Dayton today, Thursday, Sept. 7, from 6:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

The locations of the checkpoints are as follows: The first will be held in the 1500 block of East Third Street; the second will be held in the 1400 block of Wayne Avenue.

The OVI task force aims to reduce the number of alcohol/drug-related traffic crashes, injuries, and fatalities in Dayton and Montgomery County.

Sobriety checkpoints help deter impaired driving, and aid in the apprehension of impaired drivers who choose to get behind the wheel and drive. Driving while impaired is illegal and endangers the lives of everyone on the roadway.
