The Dayton Mediation Center (DMC) will acknowledge its community volunteers and celebrate its 36-year history of providing providing free and low-cost conflict intervention services with its annual Volunteer Recognition Dinner. The event takes place on Thursday, Sept. 28, from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at Sinclair Community College Building 12 (Charity Earley Room).

DMC volunteers (who serve as mediators, community impact panelists, advisory board members, ambassadors and office assistants) have helped make it possible for participants to receive conflict intervention services since 1987.

In 2023, the Dayton Mediation Center will provide conflict intervention services for approximately 2,900 cases involving over 8,700 citizens, for estimated savings to the community of over \$1,305,000. The Mediation Response Unit (MRU) is a new City of Dayton initiative providing an alternative response to non-emergency calls to police. The MRU is on pace to respond to approximately 2,800 calls for service in 2023.
