



## **United Airlines begins Denver service from Dayton International Airport**

Dayton travelers will be packing their bags for Denver, Colorado, as the inaugural flight takes place Friday, September 29, at 9 a.m. with United Airlines.

“Today we celebrate the new United nonstop route from Dayton (DAY) to Denver (DEN), making Ohio more accessible as we continue to attract new businesses and opportunity for Ohioans,” said Ohio Governor Mike DeWine.

“We’re so pleased United Airlines is bringing this Denver flight to Dayton—especially for our passengers,” added City of Dayton Director of Aviation Gil Turner. “Not only is Denver a great destination, but Denver also provides for connections westward and beyond.”

Daily flights to Denver International Airport will depart at 9 a.m. EST and arrive at 10:18 a.m. MST. Return flights depart from DEN each day at 5:20 p.m. MST and arrive DAY at 10:03 p.m. EST.

“The western-most direct flight from the Dayton International Airport taking off today demonstrates that the JobsOhio Air Service Restoration Program, paired with assistance from local airports and economic development entities, is successfully attracting valuable commercial flights for Ohioans,” said J.P. Nauseef, JobsOhio President and CEO. “This new United Airlines route came with strong collaboration of several Team Ohio partners and will benefit both Dayton-area businesses and leisure travelers with cross-country travel.”

“We’re excited to bring this new, non-stop flight to the Miami Valley and thank our partners at the Dayton International Airport and the greater Dayton area community for their continued collaboration,” said Mark Weithofer, United’s Managing Director of Domestic Network Planning. “This new flight builds on United’s current service, and we look forward to continuing to connect Dayton to United’s global route now via Denver.”

Denver is in the top 20 markets visited by local travelers in the Dayton catchment area. Historically, Denver has been a popular market. 2020 was the last time Dayton International Airport had nonstop service to Denver.
