



## **Latest Dayton Recovery Plan investment: New restrooms at Liberation Park**

The City of Dayton has announced the newest Dayton Recovery Plan community investment, following approval by the City Commission on Oct. 4.

A contract valued at \$121,768 was awarded to CXT Incorporated for improvements at Liberation Park. CXT will use the funds to replace restrooms at the park, located at the intersection of North Broadway Street and Superior Avenue. The new restrooms will be Cortez modular restrooms; work is expected to be underway in early 2024.

Funding will be provided through the Dayton Recovery Plan's \$55 million Improving Our Neighborhoods initiative, which focuses on City-led and managed projects that support neighborhood revitalization. The City of Dayton Department of Public Works will oversee contract implementation.

In June of 2022, the park's name was changed from Dayton View Park to Liberation Park. COAL, the Coalition On African Liberation, composed of Black-led organizations in West Dayton, led the effort for the name change.

The Dayton Recovery Plan is a \$138 million framework for community COVID relief and investment for the future, made possible by the federal American Rescue Plan Act.
