  - Request your deliveries be dropped off at your work or with a neighbor
  - Ask for a signature upon delivery
  - Be a good witness if you see someone taking a package off someone's porch
1. Get a good description of the person
  2. Did they walk, arrive by bicycle, or car?
  3. Which direction did they go?
