EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT

EITC



Put extra cash in your pocket!

The earned income credit (EITC or EIC) is a refundable tax credit for low- to moderate-income working individuals and couples, particularly those with children. **You may qualify (SEE GUIDELINES BELOW)!**



**EITC up to
\$7,430**

If you lived with **three or more children** in 2023 and your family **earned a max of \$56,838 (or a max of \$63,398 for married workers)**, then you can get up to **\$7,430**.



**EITC up to
\$6,604**

If you lived with **two children** in 2023 and your family **earned a max of \$52,918 (or a max of \$59,478 for married workers)**, then you can get up to **\$6,604**.



**EITC up to
\$3,995**

If you lived with **one child** in 2023 and your family **earned a max of \$46,560 (or a max of \$53,120 for married workers)**, then you can get up to **\$3,995**.



**EITC up to
\$600**

If you had **no children** living with you in 2023 and you **earned a max of \$17,640 (or a max of \$24,210 for married workers)**, and you were between the ages 25 and 64, you can get up to **\$600**.

Get Free Help Filing Your Tax Return! Fast Refunds, No Fees!

IRS-trained volunteers are available to help EITC eligible workers fill out their tax forms for free. **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) sites are open from January 23rd through April 15th.**

For information about other FREE tax preparation sites in the Dayton area, call 937-913-2000

You must bring the following items to the tax preparation sites:

- Photo ID
- W-2 Forms for wages earned in 2023
- Social Security (S.S.) cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITIN) for you and all persons in your family included on your tax return
- If you had Child Care expenses in 2023 bring the Provider's S.S. # or Employer ID Number (EIN) and address. Also, bring payment documentation for the total amount you paid to the Provider, and the amount you paid for each child.

- Any correspondence you received from the IRS in 2023 and 1098 & 1099 forms (if any)
- If you want your refund directly deposited into your savings and/ or checking account(s) bring your account number(s) with you to the tax site.
- If you are married filing jointly, both parties must be present in order to process the tax return.
