



## **Sanitary sewer project is underway in downtown Dayton**

"No-dig" work will reduce disruption

The City of Dayton Department of Water has begun work to improve the sanitary sewers under Perry Street and Longworth Street (from First Street to Stout Street) in downtown Dayton.

The project consists of lining approximately 5,600 linear feet of 30"-42" brick sanitary sewer using a trenchless technology involving extruded jointless and seamless pipe liner. The work is slated to be complete by the end of March.

Liner installation is a "no-dig" repair method which strengthens the existing pipe and seals the sewer main line from leaking. The work is less costly, quicker, and less disruptive than removal and replacement of the existing sanitary sewer.

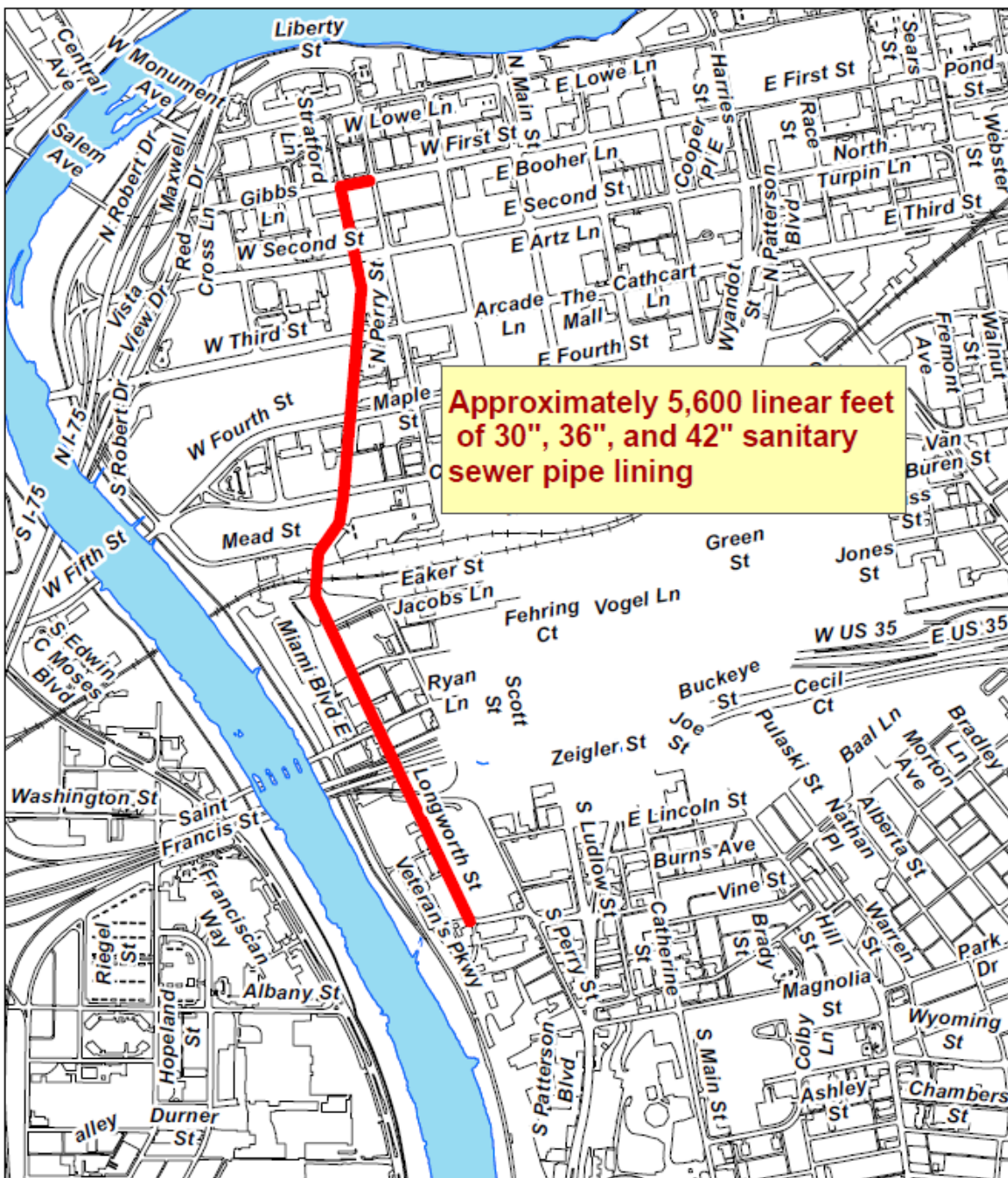
Drivers, cyclists and pedestrians traveling through the area will experience traffic changes. In creating a temporary sewer bypass, pipe will be laid above ground and equipment will be positioned along roadways. On-street parking around manholes in the work zone may be temporarily prohibited. Lane closures will move with the work as the project progresses.

Occupants of buildings in the project area will receive additional information and instructions on a door hanger placed ahead of any work affecting the immediate area. Cleaning and video inspection will be performed ahead of the liner installation and occupants may be asked to complete tasks such as flushing toilets to check for any issues. Building occupants will also be asked to reduce water usage for 8 to 12 hours during liner installation and to open windows for ventilation if needed after lining occurs.

Property owners and large stakeholders affected by the project, such as RTA and Sinclair Community College, were notified in October and November.
