The Dayton Police Department and Combined Agency OVI Task Force members of Montgomery County announced today that we will operate four (4) sobriety checkpoints during the start of Memorial Day weekend.

The locations of the first 2 checkpoints in the City of Dayton are as follows. Thursday, May 23, 2024, from 18:30 (6:30 PM) to 23:30 (11:30 PM). The first will be held in the 1500 Block of E. Third St. The second will be held in the 1400 block of Wayne Ave,

The 3rd and 4th checkpoint will be held on Friday May 24th between the same above listed hours. The location will be released that day.

The OVI task force aims to reduce the number of alcohol/drug-related traffic crashes, injuries, and fatalities in the City of Dayton and Montgomery County. Sobriety checkpoints help deter impaired driving, and they aid in the apprehension of impaired drivers who choose to get behind the wheel and drive.

Driving while impaired is illegal and endangers the lives of everyone on the roadway.
