The Dayton Police Department and Combined Agency OVI Task Force members of Montgomery County announced today that we will operate four (4) sobriety checkpoints during the start of Memorial Day weekend.

The locations of the second 2 checkpoints held in the City of Dayton are as follows. Friday, May 24, 2024, from 18:30 (6:30 PM) to 23:30 (11:30 PM). The first will be held in the Stanley Av and Troy St. The second will be held in the S. Smithville and Linden Ave.

The OVI task force aims to reduce the number of alcohol/drug-related traffic crashes, injuries, and fatalities in the City of Dayton and Montgomery County. Sobriety checkpoints help deter impaired driving, and they aid in the apprehension of impaired drivers who choose to get behind the wheel and drive.

Driving while impaired is illegal and endangers the lives of everyone on the roadway.

Law enforcement officers from the Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will provide operational support for the checkpoint.
