The Dayton Police Department and Combined Agency OVI Task Force members of Montgomery County will conduct or assist in sobriety checkpoints at two locations on Friday, June 28.

Combined OVI Task Force members will conduct a checkpoint on Friday, June 28, from 10 p.m. to 12 a.m., in the area of Needmore Road and Wagner Ford Road.

Preceding that checkpoint, Combined OVI Task Force members will assist the Ohio State Highway Patrol with OVI checkpoints held in or near the 4600 block of North Main Street from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

The OVI task force aims to reduce the number of alcohol/drug-related traffic crashes, injuries, and fatalities in the City of Dayton and Montgomery County. Sobriety checkpoints help deter impaired driving, and they aid in the apprehension of impaired drivers who choose to get behind the wheel and drive.

Driving while impaired is illegal and endangers the lives of everyone on the roadway.
