



Dayton is seeking renewal of its "Bicycle Friendly" status

Dayton is working to earn renewal and potential expansion of its Bicycle Friendly Community status.

The City of Dayton has submitted a renewal application to The League of American Bicyclists and is encouraging residents to complete an online survey to demonstrate the community's support of cycling.

The survey is available through Oct. 15, 2024 and is accessible at daytonohio.gov/cyclingsurvey.

Dayton earned bronze-level bicycle friendly status in 2010. Dayton's Active Transportation Plan (adopted in 2023) called for Dayton to renew and increase its bicycle friendly status.
