Dayton International Airport (DAY) Roadway to Undergo Construction

-Repairs to Terminal Drive to take place starting August 19-

Terminal Drive, the roadway used to access the Dayton International Airport terminal as well as its parking areas, will be receiving some upgrades starting Monday, August 19. All phases of construction are expected to be completed Friday, October 4. Visitors to the airport will be directed by signage to navigate any traffic changes during this time. Airport officials emphasize caution by driving slowly when driving in construction areas.

“While we strive to minimize disruptions, some areas may experience temporary closures or restricted access during the repair process,” explains Director of Aviation, Gil Turner. “We appreciate the community’s patience and understanding as we work to enhance our infrastructure.”

Contractor John R. Jurgensen Company will begin work Monday morning on the outside lane of the terminal entrance loop. The work will involve resurfacing, joint sealing, and crack filling on various concrete surfaces across Terminal Drive and access roads to Terminal Drive. A small portion of the Long Term lot will also be included in the work.
