



Dayton Survey mailed to 13,000 addresses

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The City of Dayton is seeking residents' opinions about living in Dayton and city government.

The annual Dayton Survey is arriving at approximately 13,000 randomly selected residential addresses in late August and early September. Residents should look for an envelope showing the City of Dayton logo and the message "Help the City of Dayton serve you better by taking this survey!".

The survey consists of approximately 80 questions covering a broad scope of City of Dayton services, programs, and priorities, as well as neighborhood quality-of-life issues. Residents living in single family homes, as well as apartment complexes and congregate settings, will receive mailed surveys. Participation is anonymous.

Survey respondents are asked to return the survey with their responses within two weeks of receiving the packet by mail. Residents receiving a mailed survey may also respond online at daytonresidentsurvey.org by using the PIN number indicated in the mailed packet.

The City of Dayton has surveyed residents for more than three decades. Resident response helps set priorities and policies.

The survey administrator, ETC Institute, will randomly select one respondent to win a \$500 VISA gift card. Only residents included in the initial selection group and returning a completed survey by mail or online will be included in the drawing. The resident receiving the gift card will be selected by December 2024.
