



## **New sidewalks, curbs coming to four neighborhoods**

-Commission approves Dayton Recovery Plan spending-

Residents of four Dayton neighborhoods will see new sidewalks and curbs later this year, following the Sept. 4 City Commission approval of construction contracts funded by the Dayton Recovery Plan.

The four neighborhoods are Old North Dayton, Twin Towers, Miami Chapel, and Edgemont, with five contracts totaling approximately \$3.25 million in services including removal of existing infrastructure where needed and installation of new sidewalks, curbs, curb ramps, and driveway aprons.

Three additional neighborhoods (Five Oaks, Wolf Creek, and Carillon) will have similar improvements funded by the Dayton Recovery Plan, with the work covered by contracts approved by the Commission on other dates.

Improving neighborhoods is a priority area of the Dayton Recovery Plan, with a total of \$55 million targeted to neighborhood investments. Funded activities include infrastructure improvements, demolition, housing repair/rehab, and small business support.

The Dayton Recovery Plan is the City of Dayton's framework for transformative investment of \$138 million in federal American Rescue Plan Act funds dedicated to recovering from the COVID-19 pandemic. Dayton's goal for the funding is to create long-term transformational and sustainable impacts in focus areas, as well as special initiatives with impact citywide.
