The Dayton Mediation Center will give recognition to its community volunteers at a special event on Thursday, Sept. 26, from 5:30 p.m. to 8 p.m., at Sinclair Community College Building 12, Charity Earley Room.

The Dayton Mediation Center celebrates its rich 37-year history of providing free and low-cost conflict intervention services to the Dayton area, serving a vision and mission of providing non-violent processes for responding constructively to conflicts.

In 2024, the Dayton Mediation Center will provide conflict intervention services for approximately 6,000 cases involving over 8,700 community members. DMC has 76 active volunteers that serve as mediators, panelists, board members, and administrative support.
