## **City to Break Ground on New Police Building**

The City of Dayton will break ground on a new police building adjacent to the historic Wright Company Factory on Wednesday, October 9, 2024. This new building will serve as the new home for the West Patrol Operations Division.

The last police station building was constructed in 1991. The total cost of the building is approximately \$5.5 million, which marks the most significant investment in Dayton Police facilities in more than 30 years. When the building is finished in late 2025, the West Patrol facility will move from 951 Washington to the new location at West Third Street and Abbey Avenue. Additionally, additional improvements will be made to the property to help prepare the area for future development.

Officials from the City and the Dayton Police Department will break ground on the new location at a ceremony at 11:00 a.m. on October 9, 2024.
