After working to understand each other's positions and interpretations of the tentative agreement, both parties believe it is important to set our differences aside for the benefit of Dayton Police officers and the safety of our community.

To resolve the differences, the City will implement the tentative agreement as requested by the FOP. While the City maintains that the tentative agreement was not intended to be interpreted this way, the City also recognizes the value of retaining our officers and the importance of preserving a positive relationship between the City and the FOP.
