The Dayton Police Department and members of the Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will operate two sobriety checkpoints on Friday, Nov. 22, in Dayton.

The checkpoints will occur between 7 p.m. and 12 a.m. in the area of 1500 E. Third St. (near Terry Street) and in the area of 2300 Stanley Ave. (near Troy St.).

Sobriety checkpoints help deter impaired driving and aid in the apprehension of impaired drivers who choose to get behind the wheel and drive. Driving while impaired is illegal and endangers the lives of everyone on the roadway.
