City Commissioner Christopher Shaw has been appointed as vice chair of the National League of Cities (NLC) 2024 Transportation and Infrastructure Services Committee, one of the NLC federal advocacy committees.

Commissioner Shaw will serve a one-year term and will provide strategic direction and guidance for NLC's federal advocacy agenda and policy priorities on transportation and infrastructure. He joined the committee as a member in 2022. The new appointment was announced by NLC President Sharon Weston Broome.

As committee vice chair, Commissioner Shaw will play a key role in shaping NLC policy positions and advocating on behalf of America's cities, towns, and villages before Congress, with the administration, and at home in Dayton.

Being appointed vice chair of the National League of Cities' Transportation and Infrastructure Services Committee is a great opportunity to advocate for Dayton's priorities from passenger rail to local investment," said Commissioner Shaw. "As we enter a period of potential challenges for cities across the country, I'm committed to providing Dayton with a seat at the table and working with other city leaders nationwide to advance local transportation and infrastructure projects."

In addition to Commissioner Shaw, the leadership of the 2024 Transportation and Infrastructure Services Committee will consist of Chair Vanessa Fuentes (councilmember, Austin, Texas) and Riakos Adams (councilmember at-large, City of Killeen, Texas).
