



New Year holiday to affect waste collection schedule

-Live tree collection available in Dayton through Jan. 17-

The City of Dayton Division of Waste Collection will provide services on a revised schedule because of the New Year holiday:

Dayton: There will be no collection on Wednesday, Jan. 1, resulting in a one-day delay of garbage and recycling pickup for the remainder of the week. There is no bulk collection scheduled in Dayton this week.

Moraine: Collection will occur on Saturday, Jan. 4.

Jefferson Township: There will be no collection on Wednesday, Jan. 1. Garbage collection will occur on Thursday, Jan. 2, and Friday, Jan. 3. Bulk waste and recycling will be picked up on Saturday, Jan. 4.

Collection of live Christmas trees will be provided in Dayton neighborhoods through Jan 17. Trees should be placed at the usual collection point for the scheduled day, two to three feet from garbage and recycling containers. Lights, decorations, etc., must be removed. After Jan. 17, trees will be collected by scheduling bulk collection service at 937-333-4800.

Customers are reminded to place containers at the collection point by 6:30 a.m. on collection day.
