The Dayton Mediation Center is looking for volunteers to share wisdom, life experiences, and time as members of Community Impact Panels designed to help divert young people from court systems.

Community Impact Panels are conversations involving a young person (ages 11 to 17), their parents/guardians, and a community volunteer.

During the conversation, youth may discuss what led to an interaction with police, including choices made, and may also discuss their goals for the future.

For participating youth, a case may be closed and sealed, with no charges on their record.
