



Weather response update for Monday, Jan. 6

Release date: Monday, Jan. 6, 2025

The City of Dayton continues a full deployment for street treatment, continuing with rotating 16-hour shifts to plow snow from roadways as quickly as possible while keeping roads open and essential traffic moving.

Over the next 16-24 hours, efforts will remain focused on Priority 1 and 2 streets and City-owned parking lots.

In the Central Business District, snow haul-out operations are underway. Haul-out is expected to continue through Thursday.

Conditions at Dayton International Airport are improving as crews continue to work on all areas. Passengers are advised to check the status of flights by contacting airlines directly or by checking the Flight Tracker at flydayton.com. Allow plenty of time to arrive safely when going to the airport.

City of Dayton waste collection services are canceled for Monday, Jan. 6. Service will tentatively be provided on a one-day delay all week; customers are advised to watch for updated information.
