The City of Dayton is creating a comprehensive Road Safety Action Plan as a key step in seeking federal Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) funding from the U.S. Dept. of Transportation.

When fully implemented, an SS4A plan can make a big difference in modernizing and improving local streets for all users, including drivers and passengers, commercial users, cyclists, and pedestrians.

This SS4A federal program was created by the “Bipartisan Infrastructure Law” of 2021 and supports systematic approaches for preventing deaths and serious injuries on the nation’s roadways.

Dayton’s Road Safety Action Plan cannot be successful without input from those who travel Dayton’s roadways. There are several ways to participate:
