The Dayton Police Department and members of the Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County announce two sobriety checkpoints for Friday, April 25, 2025.

The checkpoints will occur within the 6:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. time range at two locations: the area of Stanley Avenue at Troy Street and the area of Needmore Road at Successful Way.

The OVI Task Force aims to reduce the number of alcohol- and drug-related traffic crashes, injuries, and fatalities in Dayton and Montgomery County. Sobriety checkpoints help deter impaired driving and assist in apprehending drivers who choose to operate a vehicle while impaired.
