Access to comprehensive treatment and recovery support is vital to the well-being of our city, and we must continue to prioritize resources for those in need. I remain committed to working with our partners at every level to explore alternative solutions and ensure that no one is left behind.

We are grateful for the impact OneFifteen has made, and we will work with urgency and compassion to address the gap their departure will leave behind.

I've reached out to the president and CEO of OneFifteen to set up a meeting to discuss transition options.
